Background

The Community Development Research team is developing an interactive mapping application and process to identify, visualize, and analyze all publicly owned parcels in the region. This effort expands previous work conducted by the Transit Oriented Development Office, which was limited in scope to the transit service area.

The application was designed to provide technical assistance to communities, non-profits, and others looking to quickly identify parcels that could be good candidates for affordable housing development; however, the tool is generalized and may serve multiple purposes.

A live demonstration of the application will be provided to Land Use Advisory Committee members followed by input gathering on features to include or modify as well as ideas for ways the tool can be used.
