- Provide opportunities for both guided-learning and self-guided training, as well as discussion-focused.

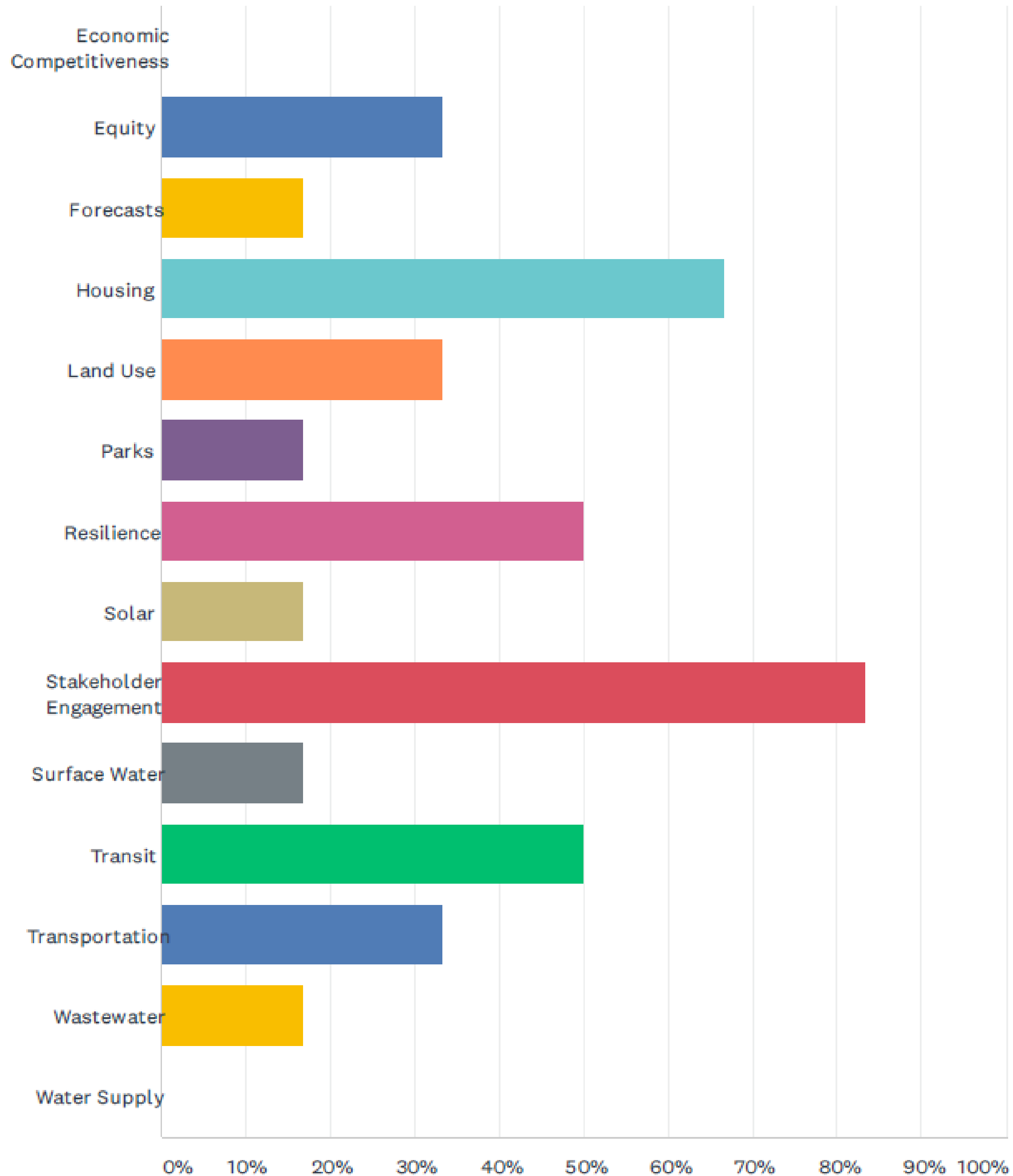
# Outreach/Survey: Priorities

- Station area planning

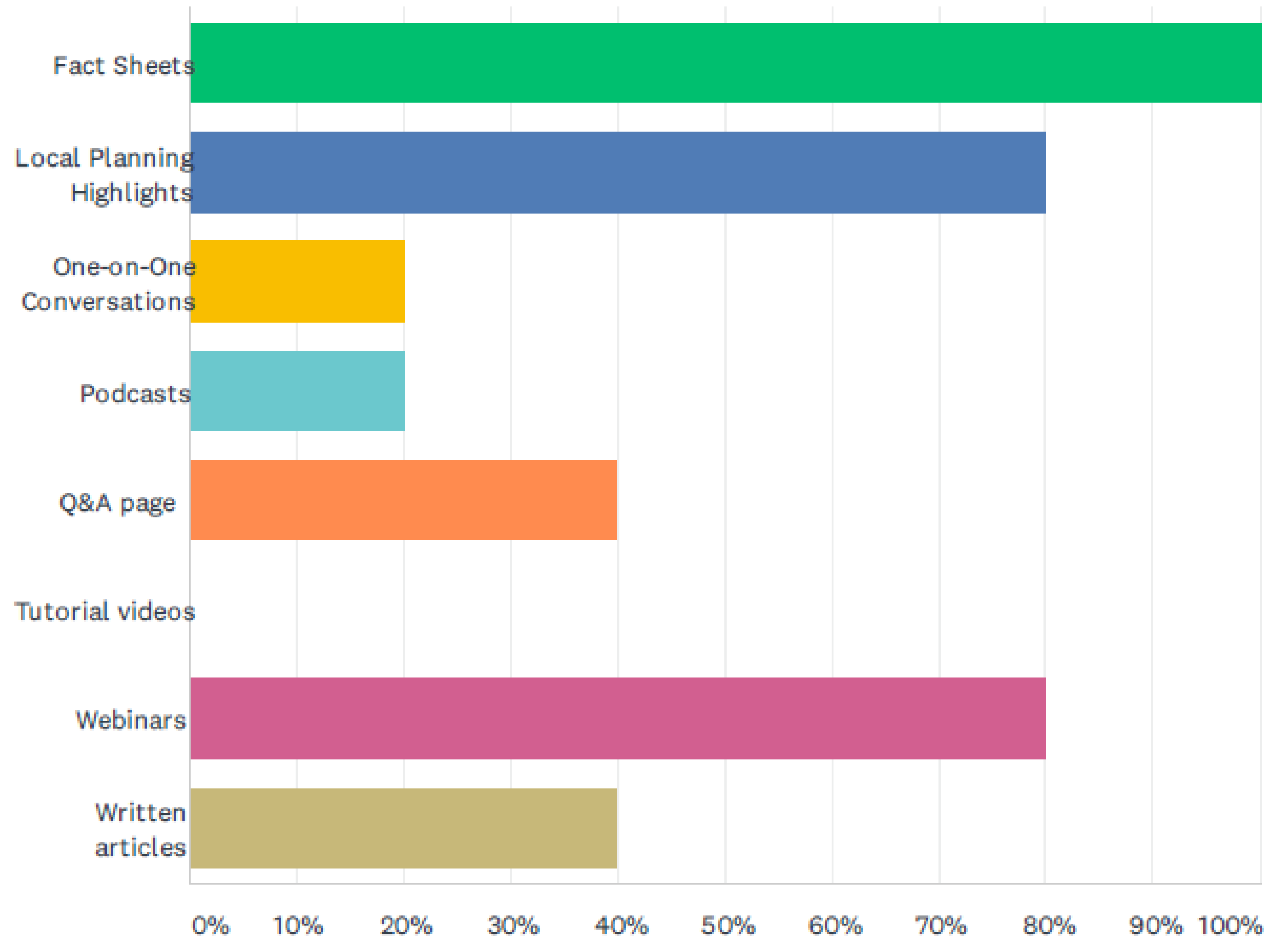
# Outreach/Survey: Barriers

- Political pressure and state regulations

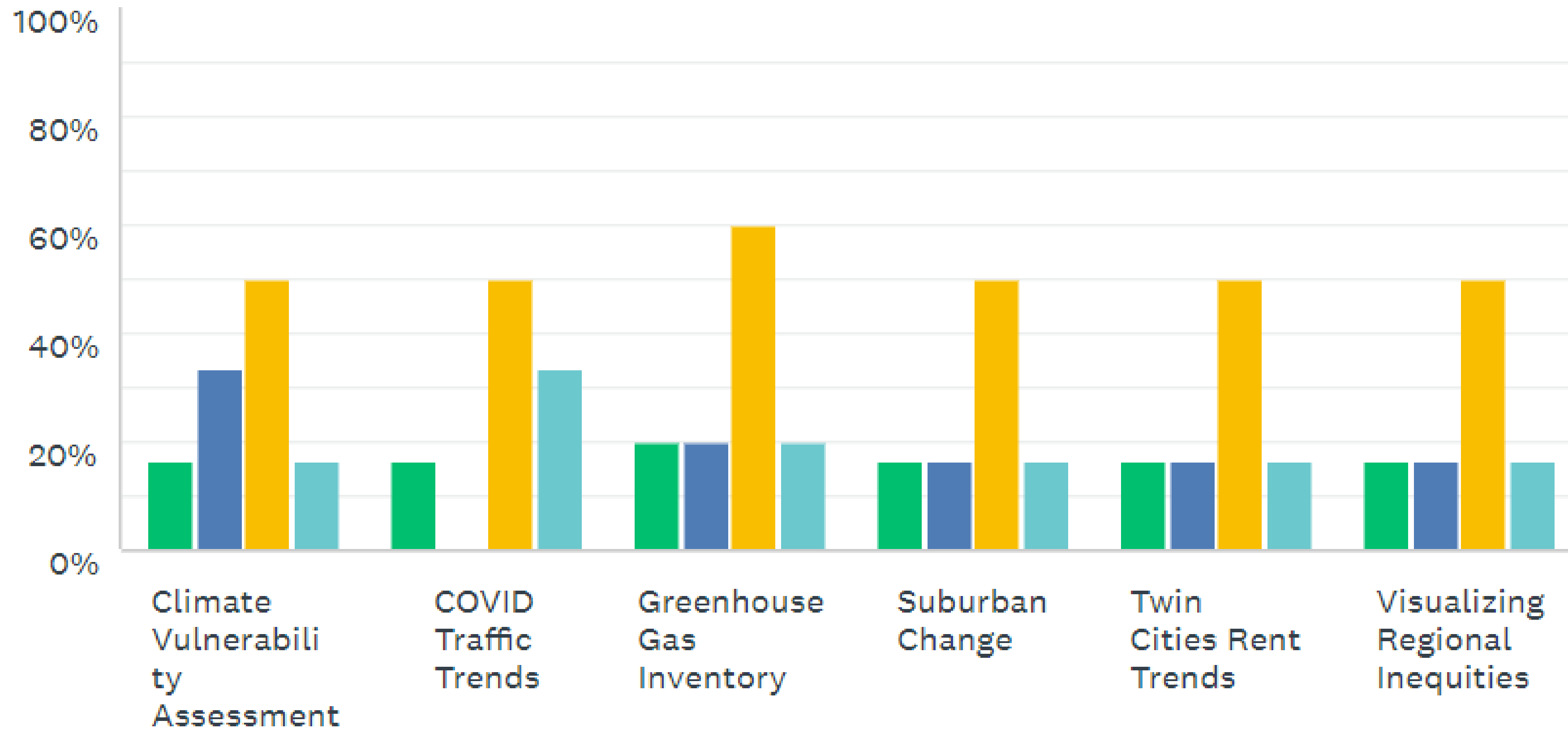
# Outreach/Survey: Where resources are needed
