## Background

At the Land Use Advisory Committee (LUAC) meeting on January 19, 2023, Council staff described the land use scenarios that emerged out of its scenario planning exercise and reported the land use findings of these scenarios. Staff then summarized how the exploration of these findings would inform the Committee's work on the 2050 Regional Development Guide. At the Committee meeting on May 18, staff will present the transportation and housing findings of the scenario planning analysis. These findings will help explore the intersections of land use with transportation and housing to inform ongoing policy discussions. Scenario planning findings help build the foundation for development of 2050 regional land use goals, policies, and strategies as part of the Council's responsibility to manage growth and development within the region.
