Proposed Action

That the Metropolitan Council authorizes the Regional Administrator to enter in an agreement with the Law Enforcement Labor Services (LELS), Inc., Local 192, Part Time Police Officers effective for the period January 1, 2013, through December 31, 2015.

Issues/Background

The LELS Local 192 contract for part time police officers expired on December 31, 2012. LELS Local 192 represents approximately 85 part time police officers at Metro Transit.

Rationale

The parties reached a tentative agreement on October 14, 2013. The LELS Local 192 membership ratified the agreement on October 26, 2013. Council policy requires the Council to approve all labor agreements.

Funding

The labor agreement was negotiated within the parameters set by the Council.
