4. Invest in Technical Enhancements




# How we will increase subcontracting opportunities

- Apply MCUB goals to more Activities
  - Design (architectural & engineering)
  - Professional/Technical
  - Other services
- Encourage MCUB inclusion & reporting on grant-funded activities

## Subcontracting inclusion

#### Benefits

- Access to more opportunities for MCUBs
- Opportunities Q1 2014 to Q3 2015:
  - Design: 3 projects (approx. \$7 million)
  - Prof./Tech. Services: 55 projects (approx. \$290 million)
  - Non-Construction: 37 projects (approx. \$135 million)

#### Challenges

- Administrative delays to review projects & efforts to include MCUBs (approx. 3 – 5 additional days)
- Increase staff resources to implement recommendations



# How we will increase business with MCUBs

- Targeted Solicitations
  - Const., design, goods & services projects under \$100K

Set division-specific MCUB benchmarks

Improve how we track MBUC business inclusion efforts



# How we will increase business with MCUBs

#### Benefits

- Access to more opportunities for MCUBs
- Opportunities Q1 2014 to Q3 2015:
  - Approx. 30,000 purchases (\$86 million)
  - Variety of purchases that today often have little MCUB participation (Goods, Prof./Tech. Services, Non-Construction)

#### Challenges

- Change in workflow to identify MCUBs to solicit & include
- Increase staff resources to implement recommendations
- Possible increased cost for certain procurements

#### Resources & Outreach

- Establish working capital loan program
- Explore reducing insurance cost barriers
- Focused outreach activities
- Provide regular resource workshops



#### Resources & Outreach

#### Benefits

- Meaningful access to contracting and subcontracting opportunities (working capital loans, explore reducing barriers caused by insurance coverage requirements & costs)
- Greater engagement and expanded relationships with small disadvantaged businesses

#### Challenges

- Resources
- Risk tolerance for loan program



#### Technical Enhancements

- Improve MCUB directory interface
- Explore providing enhanced access to procurement plans & proposals for MCUBs
- Enhance data tracking on Council usage of MCUBs
  - Create accounting mechanisms to track MCUB spend


