What is an on-site clinic?

- Located in or near employer worksite for Council employees
- Designed to look like typical provider clinic
- Staffed by Physician's Assistant
- Offers routine medical services at no cost to employees
- What it is not:
 - Minute Clinic
 - Replacement for primary care physician
 - "Company doctor"

Benefit to the Council

- Better health outcomes





- HealthPartners has 18 on-site clinics including:

 - North Saint Paul School District
 - Anoka County
 - Robbinsdale Public Schools
 - Stillwater Public Schools
 - Red Wing Public Schools



Success of Clinic Model

- Mpls Public Schools reached two-year utilization goal within 3 months – 6,914 visits since August 2012
- Mpls Public Schools has saved 10,371 production hours
- Wilson Tool has saved \$475,863 in four years
- All clinics' utilization grows year over year
- Anoka County has saved 16,632 productivity hours since May 2011
- Robbinsdale Schools hit 84% capacity within 5 months
