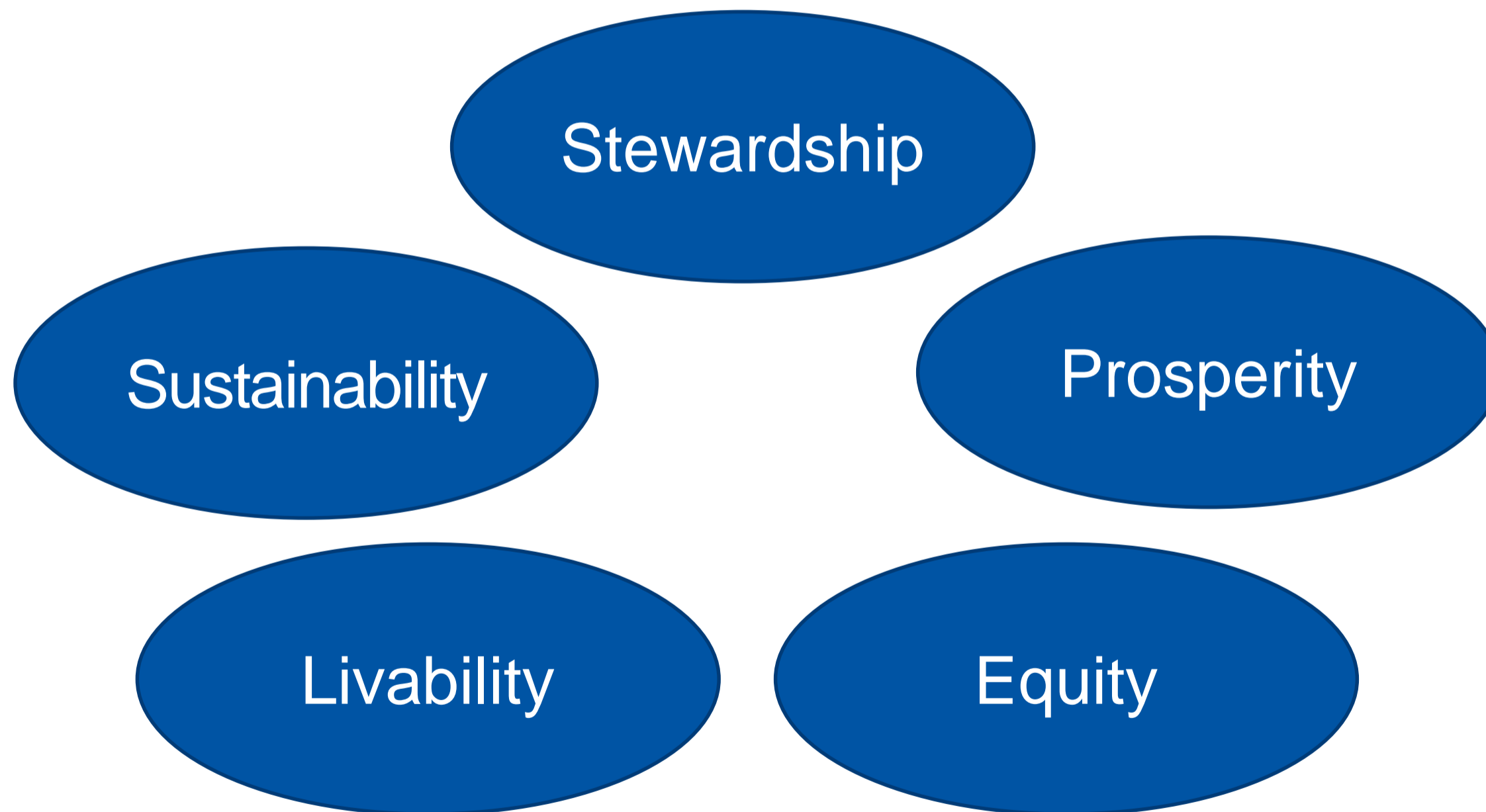
Thrive Indicators: A commitment in *Thrive*

Thrive Indicators: Characteristics



- **Intentionally limited in number**
- **Deliberately high-level** and supplemented by other indicators and the Council's own performance measures.
- Structured around the **Thrive outcomes** and meaningful in communicating the *Thrive* vision.
- **Quantifiable, maintainable, and meaningful over time.**
- **Easy to understand.**
- **Informed** by evidence-based practice and research

Implementing Thrive principles in Indicators



Integration

- Indicators that leverage multiple policy tools to address complex regional challenges

Collaboration

- Indicators that cross multiple entities; no single entity has the capacity to do the work alone

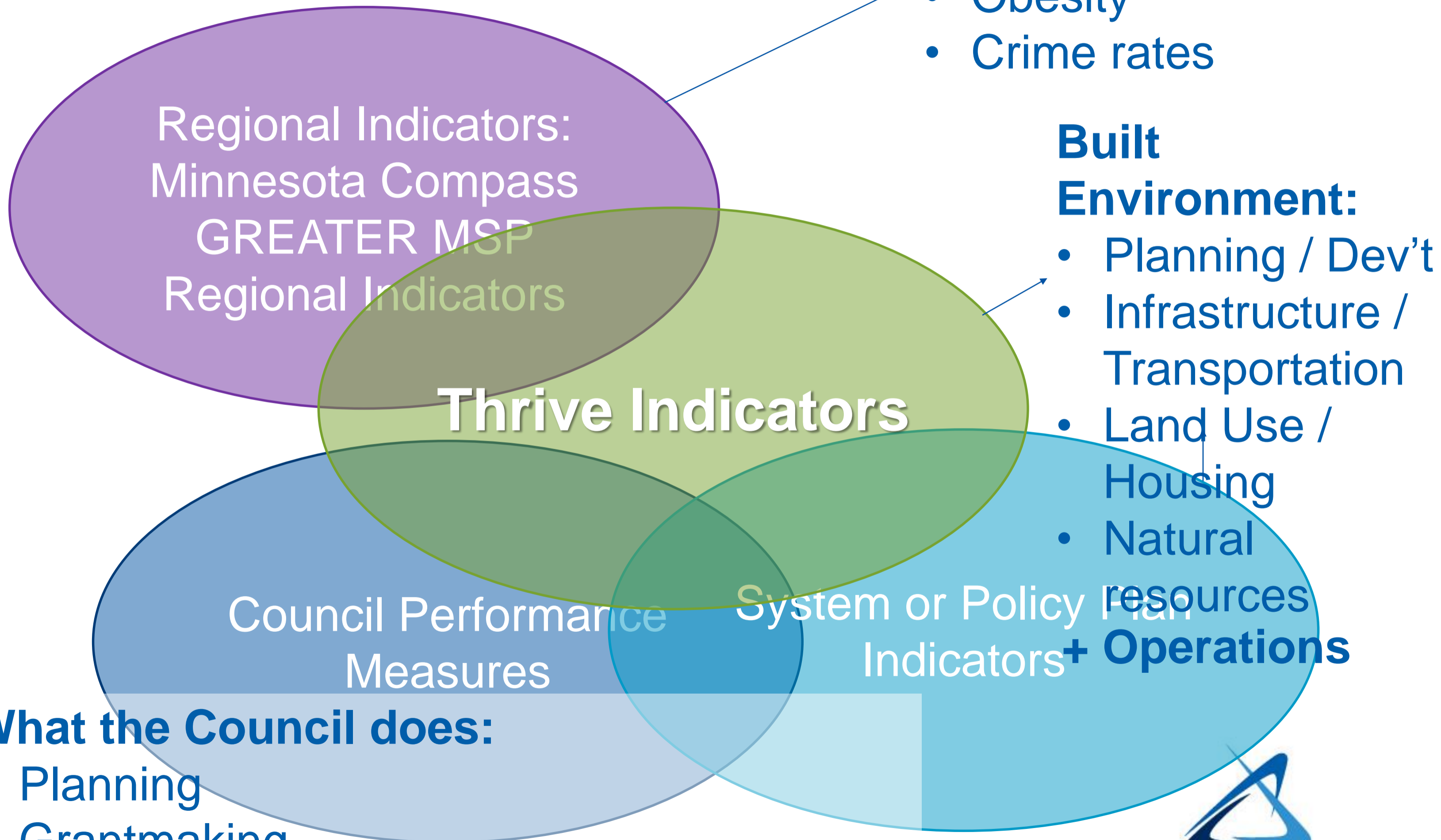
Accountability

- Monitoring the effectiveness of regional policies and practices toward shared outcomes

Cascading Indicators

Bigger than *Thrive*:

- High school grad rates
- Regional exports
- Obesity
- Crime rates



Built Environment:

- Planning / Dev't
 - Infrastructure / Transportation
 - Land Use / Housing
 - Natural resources
- Operations**

What the Council does:

- Planning
- Grantmaking
- Operations (Transit, Wastewater, HRA)
