Proposed Action

That the Metropolitan Council authorizes to bind coverage of Railroad Protective Liability insurance related to the Southwest Light Rail construction project, in an amount not to exceed \$700,000.

Background

A Railroad Protective Liability insurance policy provides coverage for liability of a railroad that may arise out of construction activities. It is generally a contractual requirement of the railroad who is granting access to its property for another party's construction activities. The Council's railroad agreements related to Southwest Light Rail construction require this coverage. At the time of the mailing, staff and Council's insurance broker continue to negotiate with insurance underwriters and will provide the details of the recommended program at Committee meeting.

Rationale

This insurance is a contractual requirement of both BNSF and TCW railways. The insurance program will meet these requirements.

Thrive Lens Analysis
