2023 and 2024 Sole Source Hardware and Software Maintenance Services

Proposed Action

That the Metropolitan Council authorize the Regional Administrator to make ongoing maintenance, hosted services and support service payments as Sole Source purchase orders in an amount not to exceed \$12,900,307. This includes installed software and hardware as listed on the attached 2024 and 20224 Information Services Sole Source Vendor list.

Background

Computer hardware and software purchased by the Council require ongoing maintenance, hosted services and support. Procurements for this hardware and software have already been completed; this item addresses ongoing maintenance and support services resulting from the initial procurements.

Council Procurement Procedure 10.4.1 addresses Sole Source procurements and provides the following guidance: "Sole source procurement of Original Equipment Manufacturer (OEM) repairs, parts, equipment and systems, software maintenance and support, or other services that are required on a continuous basis may be authorized on an ongoing basis."

Traditionally Information Services (IS) has annually brought forth a business item requesting sole source approval for one year at a time. It's the objective of IS to reduce the use of sole sources in procurements. In order improve efficiency and to reallocate time to focus on reducing the use of sole sources as well as to respond to inflationary conditions this business item covers two years of sole sources needs, 2023 and 2024.

The 2023 and 2024 Information Services Sole Source Vendor list was reviewed by Procurement staff for accuracy and reasonableness.

Rationale

The hardware and software maintenance services sole source list allows for ongoing authorization, transparency, and efficient administration of essential technology.

Thrive Lens Analysis

Maintenance services for software and hardware are needed to address the reliability, resilience, security and cost-effectiveness of the Council's technology systems which support the Thrive outcomes of stewardship and sustainability. By integrating maintenance across the Council, we are able to efficiently track efforts, which supports the Thrive accountability principle.

Funding for these software and hardware services is included in the Council's operating budget.
