2023 Second Quarter Procurement Summary and MCUB Goals Review

Background

Council *Policy 14-2 – Expenditures* authorizes the Regional Administrator to approve awards not exceeding \$500,000 for all purchases of budgeted goods and services. In addition, the Regional Administrator is authorized to approve construction contracts where:

- (a) The value of the contract does not exceed \$ \$10,000,000;
- (b) The construction project was included in the Council-adopted capital budget;
- (c) The cost of the project is less than the Engineer's Probable Construction Costs, plus 10%;
- (d) Sufficient funds are available in the capital budget to complete the project.

The delegation authority of the Regional Administrator to approve awards for all purchases of budgeted goods and services was increased from \$250,000 to \$500,000 in October of 2013. Related to this increase in authority, the Council requested a report on any contracts valued between \$175,000 and \$250,000 and \$250,000 and \$500,000.

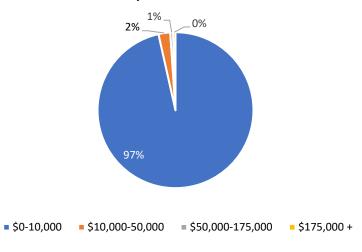
Goods and services procurements exceeding \$500,000 and construction contracts exceeding \$10,000,000 must be approved by the appropriate committee and Council. The Management Committee requested a quarterly summary of contracts. The report gives a breakdown of the number of procurements executed during the reporting period grouped by value, and details of all procurements which have a value greater than \$175,000. This report excludes interagency contracts and income/grants agreements. The second quarter 2023 Procurement Summary and OEEO MCUB Information is attached.

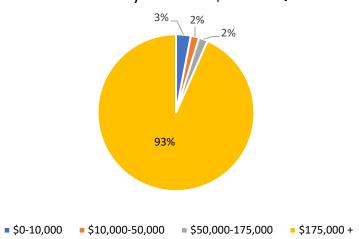

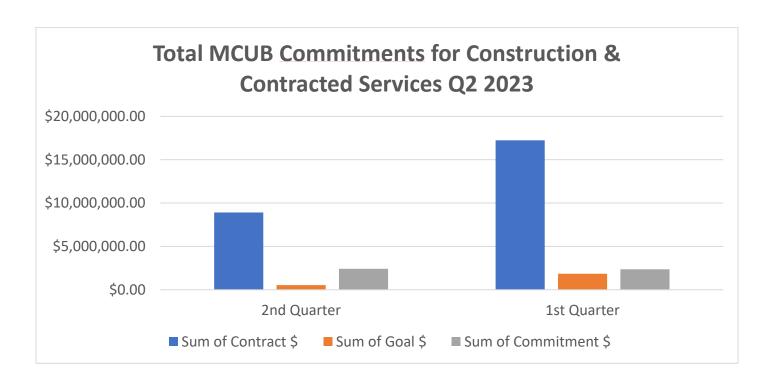

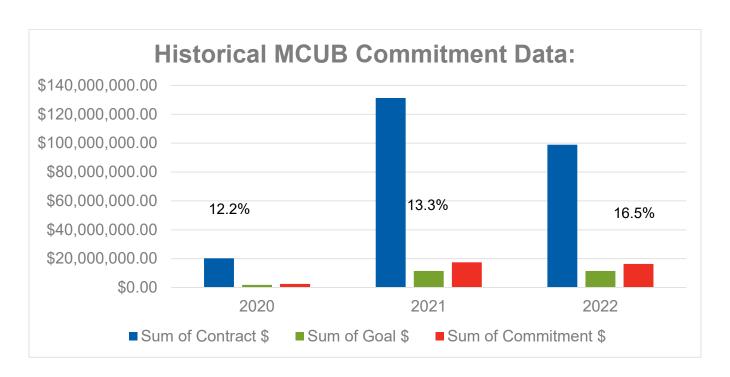
