


2024 Data Practices Request KPIs

- 777 total requests received in 2024
- Increase of <u>52%</u> from 2023 total request count of 511
- 651 total requests completed in 2024
 *84% completion rate






Steady Influx of Data Practices Requests






Division View

 Metro Transit's many data types and diffuse structure





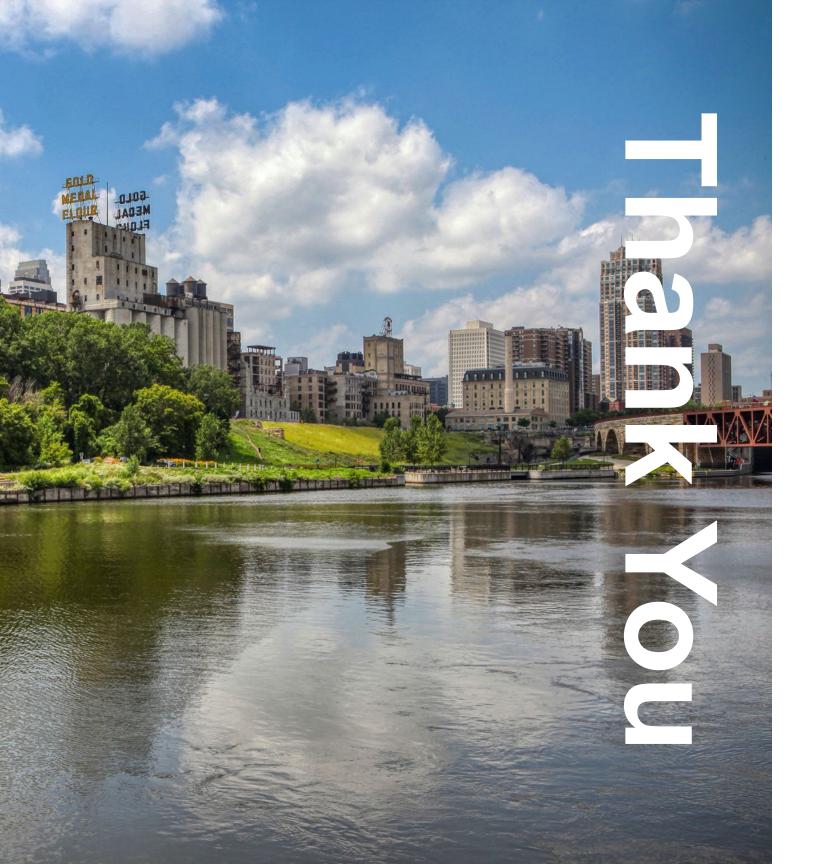


Looking Ahead
