Proposed Action

That the Metropolitan Council concur with the Transportation Advisory Board (TAB) action to amend the 2013-2016 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) to revise the scope and costs for SP#TRS-TCMT-13F, SP#TRSTCMT-13G, SP#002-596-016 and SP#002-596-018 (the four components of the Anoka County TH 65 Transit Service project).

Background

Anoka County requested a scope change for its Congestion Mitigation Air Quality (CMAQ)-funded transit service project. The TAB approved the changes to the project, which include increasing the number of buses purchased from six to seven and extending the transit service route to East Bethel and Ham Lake. Funds used from decreased land acquisition costs will be used for these changes.

Rationale

The Transportation Advisory Board approves formal amendments to the Transportation Improvement Program, and the Metropolitan Council concurs with the action of the TAB. All transportation projects that receive federal funding must be included in the TIP. These projects are exempt from air quality analysis, are consistent with the Transportation Policy Plan, and do not affect fiscal constraint.
