Proposed Action

That the Metropolitan Council authorizes its Regional Administrator to procure goods and services for network firewalls for wastewater treatment plants with Insight – Public Sector, in the amount of \$318,549.

Background

A cyber security evaluation was completed as recommended by the U.S. Department of Homeland Security. Firewalls are recommended to address access vulnerability found in the Supervisory Control and Data Acquisition (SCADA) system for the seven MCES wastewater treatment plants.

Insight – Public Sector is a network hardware, software and service provider which has a contract with the State of Minnesota. The proposed action will procure network firewalls and associated support services for seven MCES wastewater treatment plants.

Rationale

Council approval is required for procurements of goods or services valued at more than \$250,000.

Funding

Funds are available through the annual operating budget.
