### **Proposed Action**

That the Metropolitan Council authorize its Regional Administrator to award and execute a contract for construction of the East Bethel Reclaimed Water Distribution System, Project Number 801623, Contract 12P079, with S.M. Hentges and Sons Inc. for its low responsive bid of \$8,588,125.92.

### **Summary of Committee Discussion/Questions**

There was general discussion about the project, and Council Member Reynoso noted that for this phase of work, the Council is contributing \$6.9 million, and the City of East Bethel is providing \$1.6 million.

### Proposed Action

That the Metropolitan Council authorize its Regional Administrator to award and execute a contract for construction of the East Bethel Reclaimed Water Distribution System, Project Number 801623, Contract 12P079, with S.M. Hentges and Sons Inc. for its low responsive bid of \$8,588,125.92.

### Background

The East Bethel Reclaimed Water Distribution System is the remaining phase of the wastewater facilities being constructed to serve the City of East Bethel. The project consists of five miles of water piping that will deliver the effluent from the East Bethel Water Reclamation Plant to two remote land application basins where the effluent will infiltrate into the soil.

Four bids ranging from \$8,423,076 to \$9,454,255 were received and opened on February 12, 2013. The engineer's estimate was \$9,709,277. The second low bidder, S.M. Hentges and Sons Inc., offered the lowest responsive bid of \$8,588,125.92. East Bethel will provide \$1,606,128.31 as part of the Construction Cooperation Agreement with the City. The Office of Diversity and Equal Opportunity has determined that S.M. Hentges and Sons Inc. met the Metropolitan Council Underutilized Business (MCUB) goals.

### Rationale

Contract Award exceeding \$1,000,000 require Council Authorization.
