Subject: Metro Mobility Transit Assistance Agreements FY2013-2015 with DARTS

Proposed Action

That the Metropolitan Council authorizes the Regional Administrator to negotiate and execute a sole source contract with DARTS, to deliver Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) paratransit service, in an amount not to exceed \$8,376,120 for the term July 1, 2013 through June 30, 2015.

Summary of Committee Discussion/Questions

Metro Mobility Senior Manager Paul Colton presented this item and responded to requests from Brimeyer as to clarification of the timing of the various Metro Mobility contracts, and from Duininck as to clarification of the budget projections and forecasts.

Proposed Action

That the Metropolitan Council authorizes the Regional Administrator to negotiate and execute a sole source contract with DARTS, to deliver Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) paratransit service, in an amount not to exceed \$8,376,120 for the term July 1, 2013 through June 30, 2015.

Background

The Council is authorized by legislation to enter into and administer financial assistance agreements with transit providers in the metropolitan region. Under the terms of this agreement, DARTS is required to maintain full compliance with all Council policies and with state and federal laws and regulations that may apply. DARTS currently provides Metro Mobility transit service in Dakota County utilizing 35 small buses provided by the Council.

Rationale

The Metropolitan Council is responsible for ADA compliance in the metropolitan area and funds all ADA dial-a-ride services through Metro Mobility. Approval of this item will extend the current contractual relationship with DARTS for an additional two years. It is estimated that DARTS will provide 360,000 passenger trips over the two-year term. The end of this agreement aligns with the end of the Metro Mobility Demand contracts (June 30, 2015) and will be included in the competitive procurement process in 2015.

Funding

Funding for this proposed 2013 - 2015 transit service contract is included in the approved 2013 Metropolitan Council Unified Operating Budget and will be budgeted in the 2014 and 2015 Unified Operating Budget.

Known Support / Opposition
