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Background

The East Bethel Water Reclaimed Water Distribution System will provide metropolitan sewer service to the City of East Bethel. The project consists of five miles of reclaimed water piping that will deliver the effluent from the East Bethel Water Reclamation Plant to two remote land application basins where the effluent will infiltrate into the soil.

Five bids ranging from \$8,162,824 to \$10,327,700 were received and opened on June 19, 2013. The engineer's estimate was \$9,927,077. The low bid was offered by S.M. Hentges and Sons Inc. The City of East Bethel will provide approximately \$1,834,000 as part of the Construction Cooperation Agreement with the City. The Office of Equal Opportunity has determined that S.M. Hentges and Sons Inc. met the Metropolitan Council Underutilized Business (MCUB) goals.
