Proposed Action

That the Metropolitan Council ratify the final expenditures to repair Eagan Interceptor 3-ET-37.

Background

The Council ratified the Declaration of Emergency for repair of the Eagan interceptor 3-ET-37, Business Item 2013-375, at the meeting of December 19, 2012. The construction of the replacement facilities has been completed. Staff requests final approval of the costs expended for the new facilities totaling \$5,537,388. This cost is significantly higher than the \$2,500,000 originally estimated. The length of pipe requiring replacement was originally estimated at 2,500 feet. Further investigation determined that a total of approximately 6,300 feet required replacement.

Rationale

Contracts issued under emergency declaration must be ratified by the Council if the costs exceed \$100,000.

Funding

The cost of the repair, \$5,537,388, is funded from the 2013 Capital Program, Project No. 809060.
