Proposed Action

That the Metropolitan Council authorize the Regional Administrator to award and execute a 5-year contract to provide OEM materials and supplies for MCES staff with Alfa Laval Separation Inc.

Background

The Council currently has 11 Alfa Laval centrifuges in service, plus a spare rotating assembly. The centrifuges were selected and installed as part of previous capital expansion and/or improvement projects for the wastewater treatment facilities.

Rationale

The centrifuges were designed and manufactured by Alfa Laval according to their own OEM specifications and tolerances. Where non-OEM parts are available (standard bearings, seals, etc.), they are purchased following competitive sourcing procedures.
