Proposed Action

That the Metropolitan Council authorize its Regional Administrator to award and execute a construction contract for the Burnsville Interceptor Improvements, MCES Project No. 808000, Contract No. 13P103, with Lametti and Sons for their low bid of \$18,579,200.

Background

CCTV inspection of Interceptors 7030, 7033, 8560 and 3-BV-39 has revealed corrosion damage. These interceptors convey wastewater from the communities of Savage and Burnsville to the Seneca Wastewater Treatment Plant. Approximately 24,500 feet of gravity interceptor (36-inch to 72-inch diameter) sewer will be lined to restore the structural integrity of the interceptors.

Contractors were prequalified to bid on this project. A formal Invitation for Bids (IFB) was advertised for the construction contract on June 13, 2013. Plan holders included 12 general contractors and 27 subcontractors and suppliers. Four bids were received on July 23, 2013. The bids ranged from \$18,579,200 to \$38,915,366. Lametti and Sons submitted the lowest responsive, responsible bid in the amount of \$18,579,200.

This project is funded by a Public Facilities Authority (PFA) loan and has WBE and MBE goals of 3% each. The Office of Equal Opportunity has passed Lametti and Sons as meeting the numerical goal set forth in the bid documents.

Rationale

Construction contracts exceeding \$1,000,000 require Metropolitan Council authorization.
