Proposed Action

That the Metropolitan Council:

- Adopt the attached resolution authorizing the agreement with the Minnesota Department of Transportation for Surface Transportation Program (STP) funds.
- Authorize the Regional Administrator to enter into agreement with the State of Minnesota, Department of Transportation, for distribution of FHWA STP funds.

Background

The Transit On Board Survey is conducted every five years as part of the transportation planning process. The Survey will contribute valuable information to the region's Travel Demand Model, including providing information to the federally required before and after studies for the Green Line Extension and Blue Line Extension projects.

In May 2015 the Transportation Advisory Board approved \$800,000 in federal funding through the Surface Transportation Program (STP) for this project, and the Metropolitan Council has committed \$200,000 as local match. The RFP for this project has been released and work is expected to begin in January 2016.

MnDOT is the distributor of STP federal funds and requires that the Metropolitan Council take official action through the attached Resolution in order to receive and expend these funds.

This action is requested to go to the Council the same week. Metropolitan Transportation Services and Procurement identified a cooperative schedule to execute this agreement with MnDOT. Doing so will assist staff with the Request for Proposals process and obtaining MnDOT approvals, including their Disadvantaged Business Enterprise (DBE) review procedures.

Rationale

The Transit On Board Survey will provide data for use by local partners in developing transportation planning projects.



Funding

Funding is available through the STP program for a total of \$800,000 and a local match from the Metropolitan Council of \$200,000.
