## **Proposed Action**

That the Metropolitan Council authorize the Regional Administrator to amend a Customer Facility Repairs and Improvements agreement (SG-2014-094) with the Minnesota Valley Transit Authority (MVTA) in the amount of \$600,000 for a revised total of \$1,000,000.

### **Background**

This grant agreement funds repairs and improvements at customer facilities within the MVTA service area. These repairs include, but are not limited to, asphalt mill and overlay, concrete replacement (both pavement and sidewalks), lighting, relocation of customer pick-up locations and new a new access location at the Burnsville Transit Station. It may also include, but not be limited to, asphalt and concrete work at transit stations or park & ride locations, and shelter improvements at Blackhawk.

### Rationale

This grant allows MVTA to fund a transit capital project using funds distributed by the Metropolitan Council.

#### **Funding**

The \$600,000 increase to the current agreement will be funded from MVTA's undesignated NTD fund balance. MVTA's undesignated fund balance was authorized with the adoption of the 2015 Unified Budget.

### **Known Support / Opposition**

MVTA is aware of and supports this business item and requested action.
