### Proposed Action

That the Metropolitan Council authorize its Regional Administrator to award and execute a contract for construction of the NAI Rehabilitation Phase 7, Project No. 808670, Contract 15P047, with Geislinger and Sons, Inc for their low responsive and responsible bid of \$9,079,934.

### Background

The rehabilitation project includes the installation of a cured in place pipe liner system to address corrosion issues in two pipe segments and the replacement of a segment of pipe at the third location. The project includes a cooperative agreement with the city of Brooklyn Park to install a new segment of watermain adjoining the sanitary interceptor replacement.

Five (5) bids, ranging from \$9,079,934 to \$10,276,269, were received and opened on May 28, 2015. The low bid was less than the engineer's estimate of \$9,689,256. The MCUB participation goal for this contract is 7%. The Office of Equal Opportunity has determined that Geislinger and Sons, Inc. met the numeric goals for this contract.

### Rationale

Construction contracts exceeding \$2,500,000 require Council authorization.
