Proposed Action

That the Metropolitan Council authorize it's Regional Administrator to amend contract 12P0024 with Allied Barton Security Services with an additional \$200,000 from \$786,245 to \$986,245 and ~~extending the term from August 31, 2015 to October 31, 2015.~~

Background

The Council currently contracts with Allied Barton Security Services, 12P004, for Security Services at six locations including five MCES Wastewater Treatment Plants and the Robert Street building. This amendment would allow additional time to retain current levels of service while the solicitation process for the new contract is finalized and executed. The current service requires staffing levels of approximately twenty full time security officers and part-time, off-duty police officers.

Rationale

Allied Barton Security Services is best suited to continue providing the Council's security coverage until Contract 15P069 is awarded. The awarded contract is expected to occur in October 2015.

Security staffing at all six Council locations is considered necessary to protect persons and infrastructure.
