### **Proposed Action**

That the Metropolitan Council authorize the Regional Administrator to execute an amendment to the professional services Contract # 14P186 with Snow Kreilich Architects in the amount of \$537,280.

### **Background**

A contract for the design of the Metro Transit Police Department (MTPD) Facility was awarded to Snow Kreilich Architects on February 11, 2015 in the amount of \$1,648,577. During the preliminary design phase, opportunities were identified that, if incorporated with the design of the MTPD facility, could provide: additional needed administrative space on the campus, provide better connectivity between the existing campus facilities with the proposed police department, and provide economies of scale during construction. These opportunities include:

- providing additional square footage;
- developing a single main entry and common use spaces; and
- remodeling a portion of the first floor of FTH Administration Building.

These opportunities would increase new office/support space by approximately 30% and better integrate the new police department with the existing office building. This amendment will increase the contract value by \$537,280 to a total of \$2,155,857.

Snow Kreilich Architects passed the original OEO review of its proposed DBE participation in the contract. With this amendment Snow Kreilich Architects still passes the DBE participation.

#### Rationale

Authorization to amend A/E Design contracts requires Council approval if the amendment exceeds 10% of the original contract value.

#### **Funding**

Funding for the MTPD Building is available in Project 63219 and funding for the FTH Administration Building remodel is available in Project 62790.

### **Known Support / Opposition**

There is no known opposition.
