### Proposed Action

That the Metropolitan Council approve the following appointment to the Transportation Accessibility Advisory Committee, **John Clark—District H**, term ending January 2018.

### Background

The Transportation Accessibility Advisory Committee (TAAC) was established by the Metropolitan Council pursuant to MN Statute 473.375 9a. The TAAC's purpose is to advise the Council on "the development and management of policies regarding accessibility of all aspects of fixed regular route and special transportation services for persons with disabilities." The TAAC also advises the Council "on long-range plans to meet the accessible transportation needs of the disability community." The TAAC is a 16-member board which includes people who are elderly, have a disability, use special transportation, and represent appropriate agencies for people who are elderly or have a disability. The Metropolitan Council appoints eight members and the Chair. The remaining seven members are appointed by the Minnesota State Council on Disability (2), the Minnesota Consortium for Citizens with Disabilities (2), the Metropolitan Area Agency on Aging (2), and the Minnesota state AARP office (1).

### Rationale

District H on the Transportation Accessibility and Advisory Committee is vacant due to a mid-term resignation.

Mr. Clark has been a Metro Mobility customer for several years. He wants to serve on TAAC to improve service for customers by sharing his experience and perspectives as a customer.

### Known Support / Opposition
