Governor's Budget Recommendations for State Fiscal Year 2018-2019

- Released on Tuesday, January 24, 2017
- \$1.4 billion projected budget balance in FY18-19; state budget reserves at all-time high
- Governor's budget focuses on four themes: jobs, education, state government reform, and quality of life



Governor's Recommendation Transportation

Recommendation: 1/2-cent metro area sales tax

- Raises \$3 billion over ten years
- Covers transit capital and operating costs
- Accelerate the expansion of the entire system, including nearly 30% expansion of bus system by 2025
- Connects 500,000 more residents to jobs within a 30minute transit commute



Governor's Recommendation Regional Parks

Operations and Maintenance: \$17.08 million in FY18-19

State General Fund: \$5.74 million

Lottery in Lieu of Taxes: \$11.34 million

Parks & Trails Legacy: \$34.531 million in FY18-19

Maintains 40/40/20 split with DNR, Metro Regional Parks, and Greater MN Parks and Trails



Governor's Recommendation Water

Recommendation: \$2.870 million in Clean Water Funds for FY18-19

- Metro Area Water Supply Sustainability Support: \$2 million
- Water Demand Reduction grant program: \$870,000



Governor's Bonding Recommendations

- \$10 million **Metropolitan Regional Parks** to improve and expand the system. State bond funds would be matched by the Council.
- \$5 million for **Inflow & Infiltration** mitigation grants. The Council would award grants to local governments and would require a match from the local governments.



Governor's Bonding Recommendations

Other projects:

- \$25 million to the City of Minneapolis for the 35W/Lake
 Street Transit/Access Project
- \$3 million to Washington County for the Gateway
 Corridor Transitway
