Proposed Changes

- Eliminate four trips per weekday (2 per direction)
- Approximately between 2AM-4AM
- Continue 24-hour weekend service
- Pilot replacement bus service

April Activities

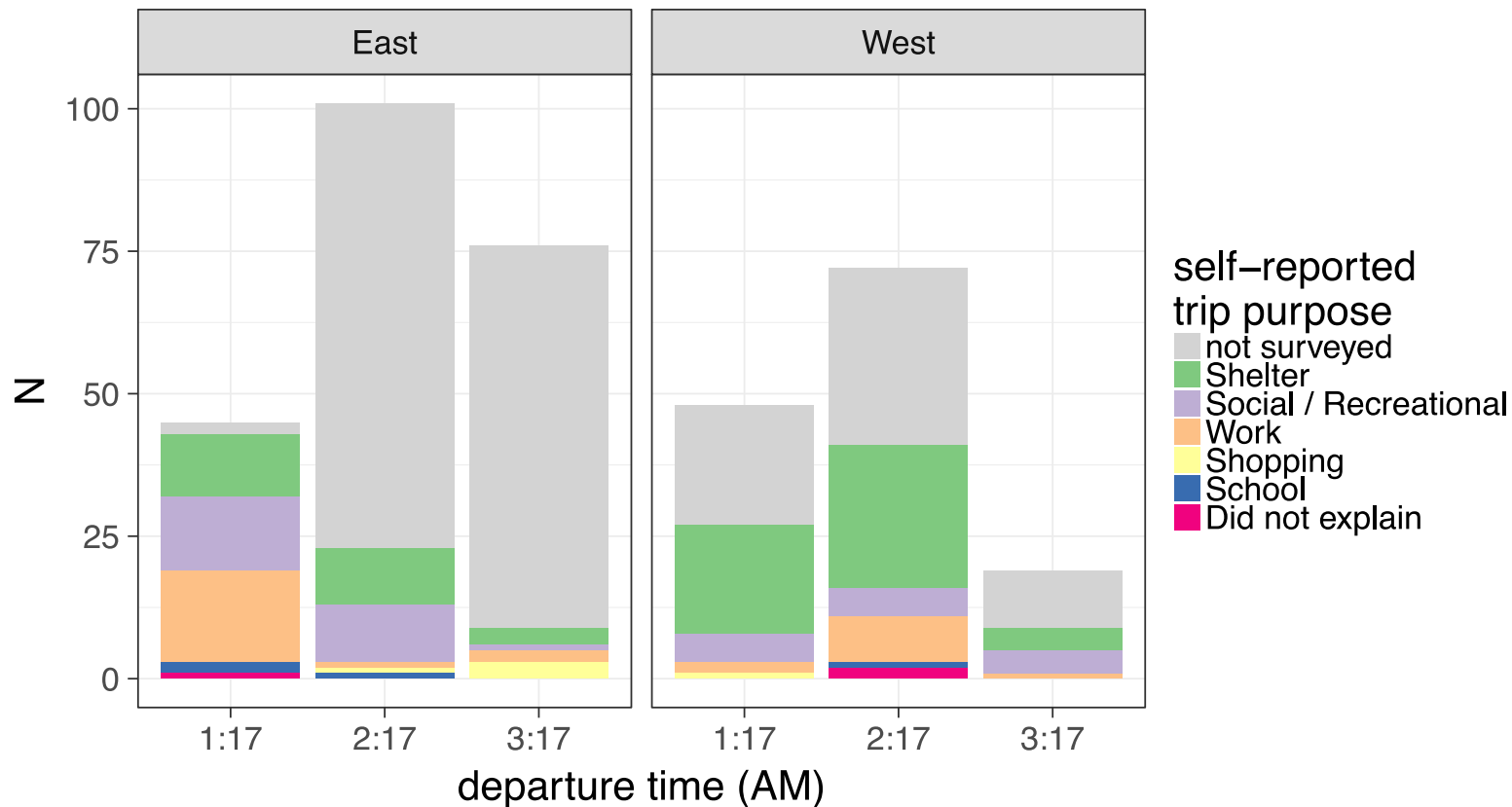
- Reviewed peer practices
- Conducted rider surveys
- Began transition planning

Overnight Rider Survey

- Purpose: understand travel between 1AM-4AM
- Method: on-board surveys conducted across 3 nights
- 283 surveys attempted
- 152 complete surveys including date, time, direction, and station

152 surveys with time & direction info



Additional Data Analysis

- Purpose of Metro Transit's April survey was to better understand riders' travel practices
- Planning to contract with Wilder Research to analyze existing data on people using transit as shelter
- Wilder Research's data analysis will inform transition planning efforts

Next Steps

- Continue HAT and Metro HRA efforts
- Coordinate transit service changes, including replacement bus plan
- Fund additional data analysis to understand needs of people using transit as shelter (pending Wilder contract)
