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# RESOLUTION NO. 2021-31 RESOLUTION ACKNOWLEDGING COUNCIL STAFF FOR THEIR EXEMPLARY WORK THROUGHOUT THE COVID-19 PANDEMIC

- **WHEREAS**, the COVID-19 pandemic has presented an unprecedented challenge to our Region and State:
- WHEREAS, for the past 19 months Council employees were required to dramatically shift operations to respond to the COVID-19 pandemic;
- **WHEREAS**, in the face of the pandemic employees of the Council displayed creativity, resilience, hard work, and perseverance to continue providing essential public services and to make this a thriving region; and
- **WHEREAS**, employee innovation throughout the pandemic will help the Council emerge from the pandemic as a stronger, better service provider and organization.

### NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED:

That the Metropolitan Council authorizes a one-time, \$500 recognition payment to all regular Council employees who are actively employed on October 29, 2021. These employees include: part-time police officers who worked 150 hours or more from January 1, 2021 to October 29, 2021; part-time operators; long-term temporary employees; and Post Retirement Option employees. This will be a lump sum payment on the November 12, 2021 paycheck that is taxable and pension eligible.
