Proposed Action

That the Metropolitan Council adopt an amendment to the 2021-2024 TIP to add an additional location and additional cost to Richfield's West 77th railroad gates installation.

Background

This amendment request is necessary to reflect a change in project scope, adding a second location (upgrading detection circuitry adjacent to W 76th Street) to Richfield's West 77th Street installation of gates and flashing lights. This addition also includes a cost increase. The project is funded through the Highway Rail Grade Crossings & Rail Safety program, which is not programmed through the Regional Solicitation.

Rationale

The Metropolitan Council approves formal amendments to the TIP. The project is consistent with the Transportation Policy Plan (TPP) and meets fiscal constraint because the federal funds are sufficient to fully fund the project. The Minnesota Interagency Air Quality and Transportation Planning Committee determined that the project is exempt from air quality conformity analysis.

The project is fully funded with federal and local funds.

PROJECT BACKGROUND:

This formal amendment is needed reflect a change in scope by adding a second location and a total project cost increase.

The total project cost increased from \$225,000 to \$350,142. Additional federal funding is provided from RRS-C (MnDOT Rail Office) and local funds from Richfield. Therefore, fiscal constraint is maintained.
