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Background

The Council and SCRRA are parties to a Northstar Corridor Commuter Rail Master Operations Funding Agreement effective on or about May 30, 2007, to establish a mechanism for transferring funds from the Sherburne County Regional Railroad Authority for the operations of a commuter rail transit system along the Northstar Corridor from downtown Minneapolis to Big Lake, MN. The parties to the Master Operations Funding Agreement provided in that agreement the local funding for the annual operations of the Commuter Rail Line would be determined in subsequent Subordinate Funding Agreements. This Subordinate Funding Agreement is for the 2023 Sherburne County 8.05% share of the net subsidy of the 2023 Northstar Commuter Rail.

Council Policy FM 15-1 requires Council approval on income agreements exceeding \$500,000.

Rationale

The Subordinate Funding Agreement will provide the 2023 Sherburne County 8.05% of the net subsidy of the 2023 Northstar Commuter Rail Operations 2023.
