Proposed Action

That the Metropolitan Council authorize its Regional Administrator to execute a Cooperative Construction Agreement with the City of Lakeville for the construction of new flow meter M657, MCES Project No. 805609, for an amount not to exceed \$1,000,000.

Background

In 2008 interceptor 8007 was constructed through the City of Farmington to provide future service to the eastern portion of the City of Lakeville. To facilitate future development and treatment cost allocation between communities, Environmental Services planned a future project that would construct a flow meter that captures flow rate data from Lakeville into Farmington.

Rationale

The City of Lakeville, City of Farmington and Metropolitan Council would benefit from including construction of new meter M657 in the City of Lakeville's upcoming project. The Project work for the Council would be contracted by the City with construction planned between 2024 and 2026.

Council policy requires interagency agreements with expenditures valued at greater than \$500,000 to be approved by Council.
