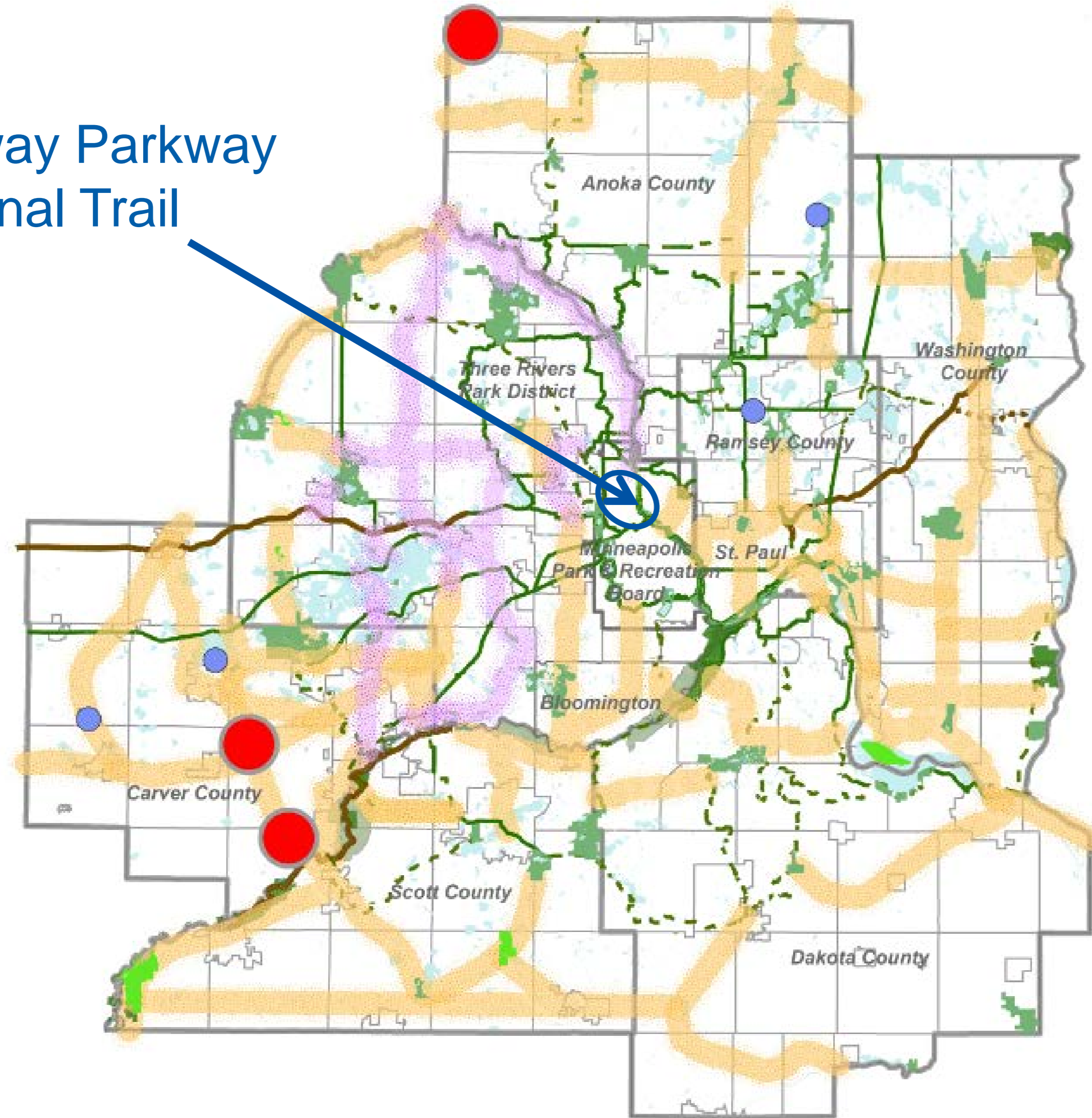

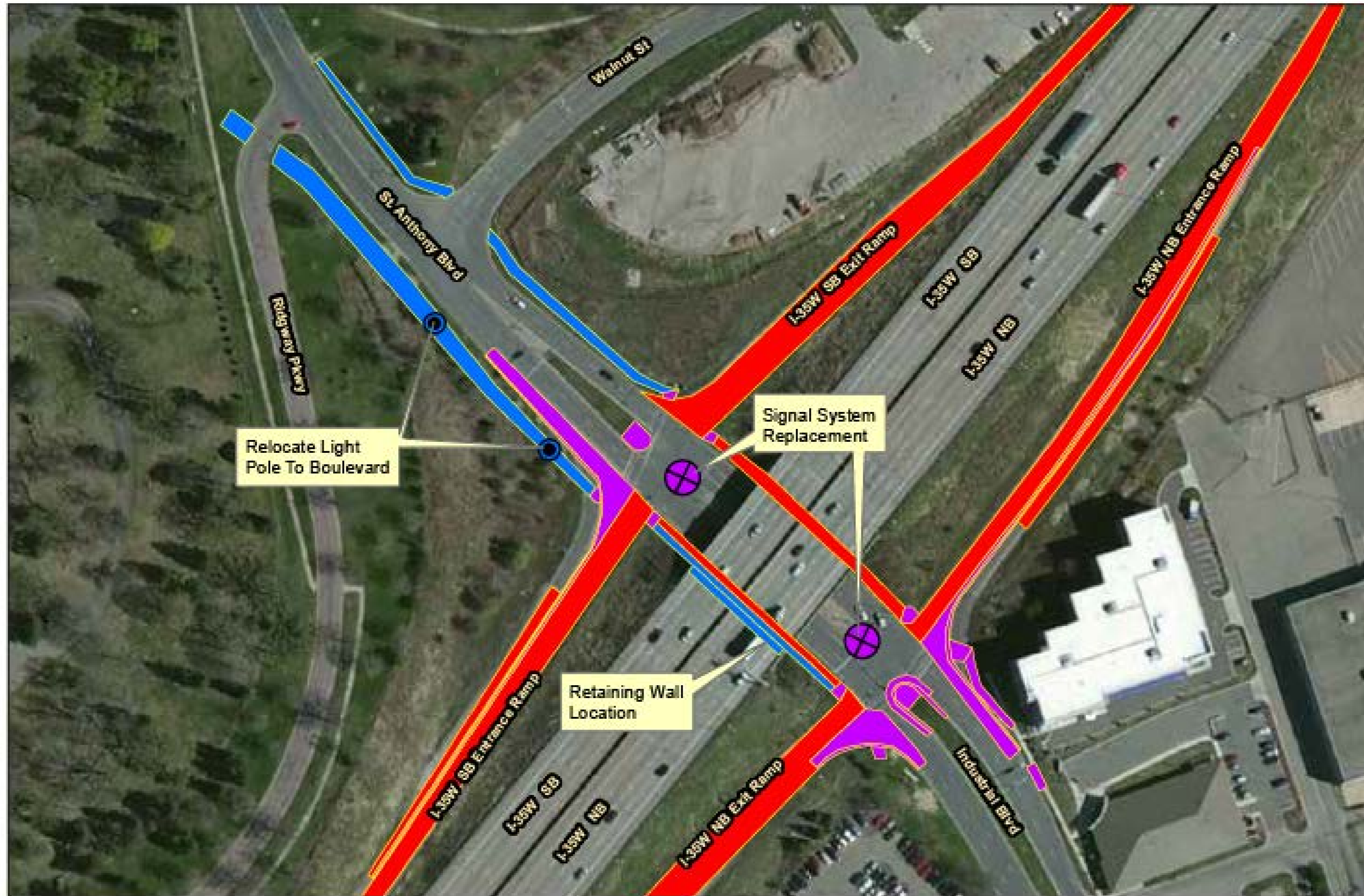
Figure 1 – Ridgway Parkway Regional Trail boundary
