



Land Conversion

Removal: 2.42-acres

- Removes land that is only accessible from the Veterans Rest Camp due to wetlands and drainage ways.
- Sized to not disturb wetland.

Replacement: 2.42-acres







Rationale for Proposed Action

- Other Council policies








Proposed Action
