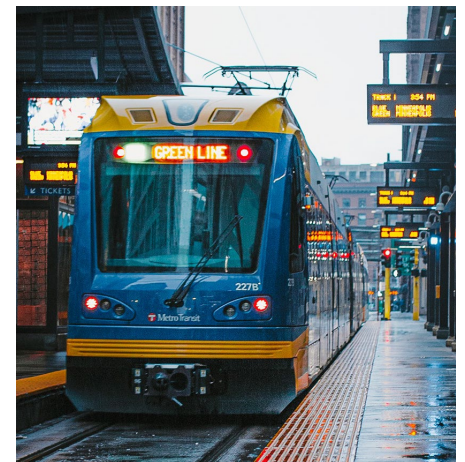
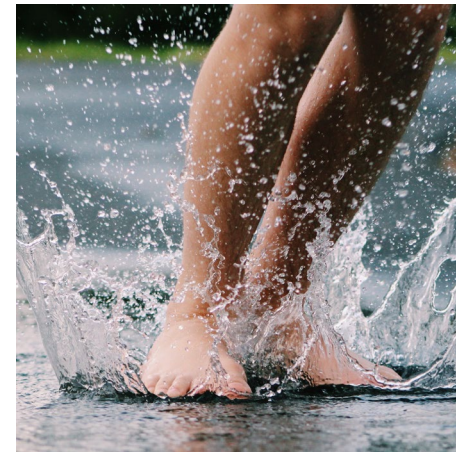
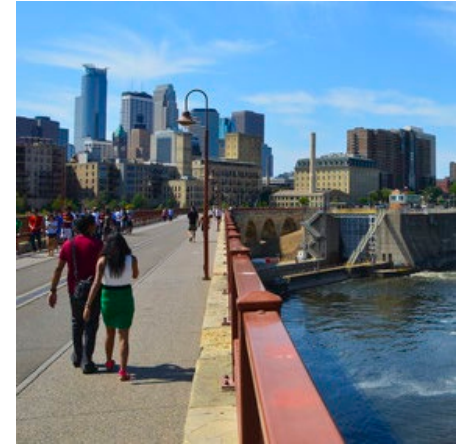
2050 Plans Timeline

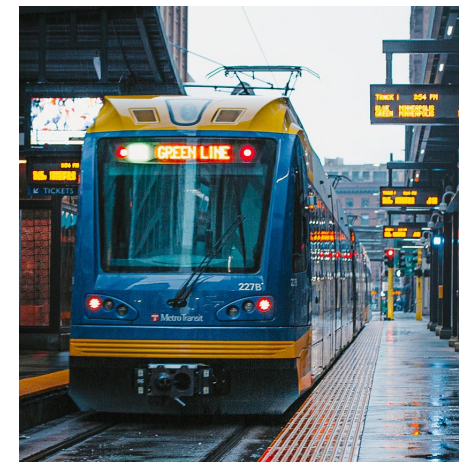
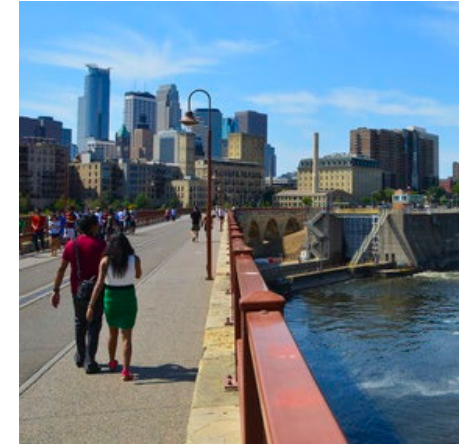
