- Make policy playful and fun with creative practices and artistic expression
- Break down complex issues through continued arts-based engagement
- Produce art for policy, using our buildings, parks, infrastructure, fleets, and cities as the canvas

Art + Policy Project Scope

Phases

1. Regional Arts Exhibition

- Four artists create illustrations for regional display (bus & train wraps, park signs, public site posters, etc.)

2. Artist-Led Engagement

- Nine artists do pop-up engagement, any artistic medium

3. Council Engagement Tools

- Games, interactives, Social Pinpoint

4. Community Conversations

- Multi-part series focused on RDG goals and themes

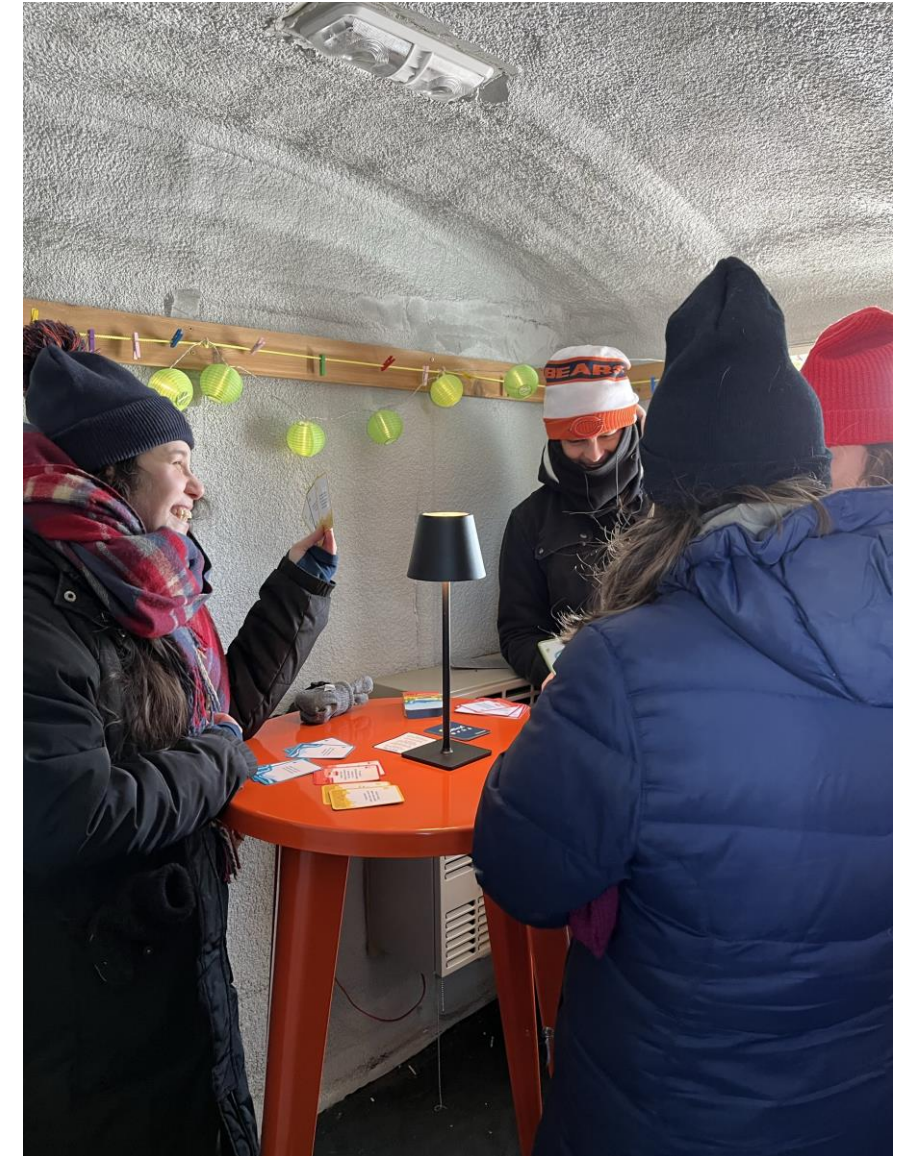
