What is Thrive MSP 2040?

- The long-range plan that creates a vision for the seven-county region for the next 30 years
- The update to the 2030 Regional Development
 Framework that provides the policy direction for the
 next round of the Council's systems and policy plans,
 including the Transportation Policy Plan
- A plan to help our region maximize opportunities for growth and prosperity for the coming decades.





The Twin Cities in 2040:

- A great place for our diverse and growing population
- A region that attracts and retains talent, jobs and economic prosperity



Regional Planning Cycle

- Local Comprehensive Plan Updates (2018)
- Systems Statements (2015)
- Systems and Policy Plans (2014-15)
- Thrive MSP 2040 (2014)



Timeline for *Thrive MSP* 2040

- Fall 2012: Principles and Goals; Analysis of Regional Development Framework; Development of Alternative Policy Scenarios
- Winter 2013: Reactions to Alternative Policy Scenarios and Development of Preferred Policy Scenario
- Summer 2013: Reactions to Preferred Policy Scenario and Development of Final Draft
- Fall 2013: Public Meetings / Public Hearing
- February 2014: Adoption of Thrive MSP 2040
