# Facility History

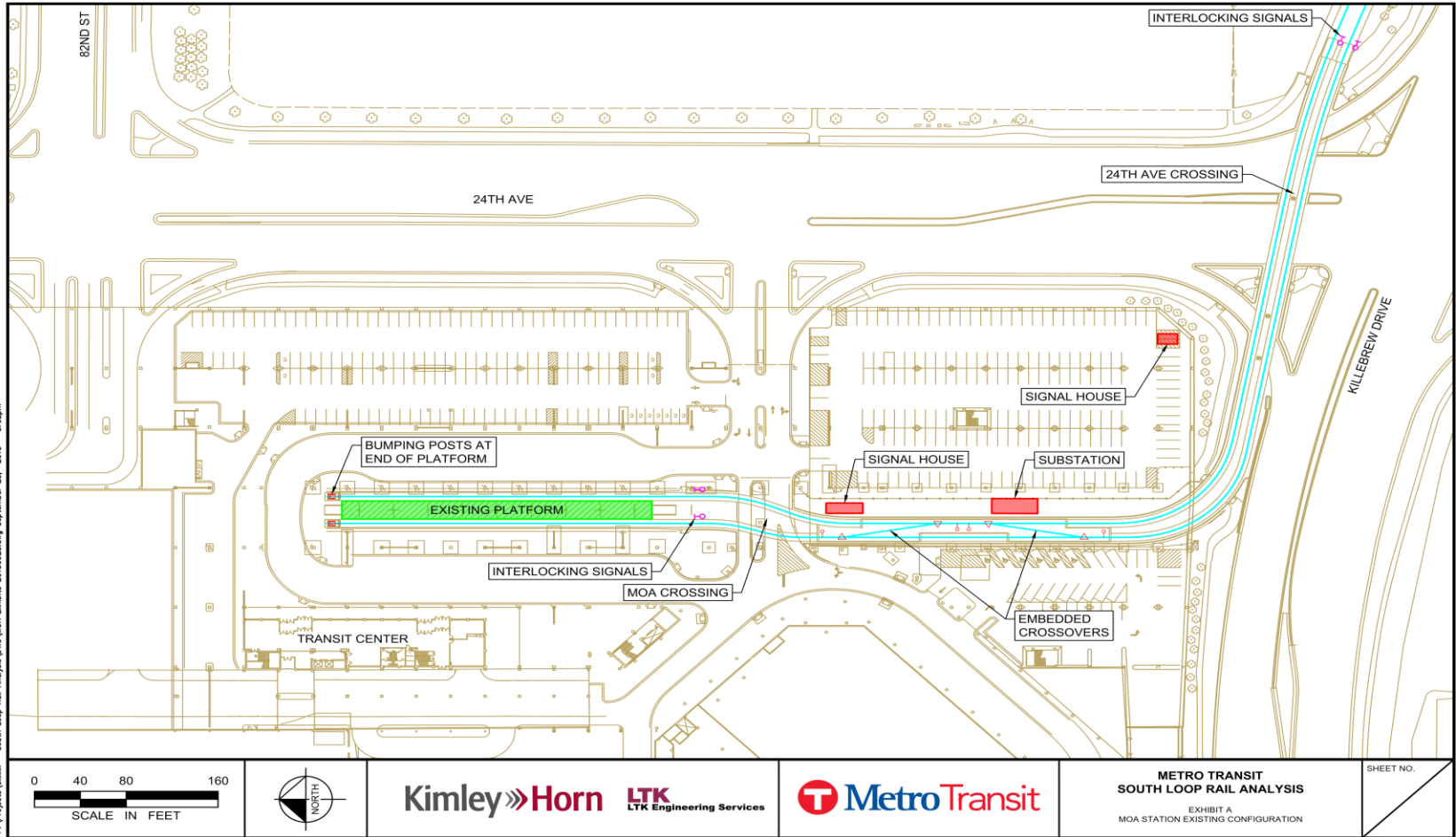
- **Rail Built in 1992 as a Bus Time Transfer Facility**
- **Modified in 2004 for the opening of Light Rail**
  - **Remodeled Transit Station Waiting Area**
  - **Addition of LRT tracks**
    - **Reduced number of bus gates**
    - **Divided the area**
- **Added Red Line Platform in 2014**

# Project Objectives

- **Eliminate Bus Waiting at Station Entry.**
- **Locates High Frequency/Capacity Services in Close Proximity.**
- **Eliminates Need for Red Line and Blue Line Passengers to Cross Busway**
- **Provides preferred siting for Metro Mobility Operation**
- **Provides Convenient Waiting Area and Direct Access to MOA**

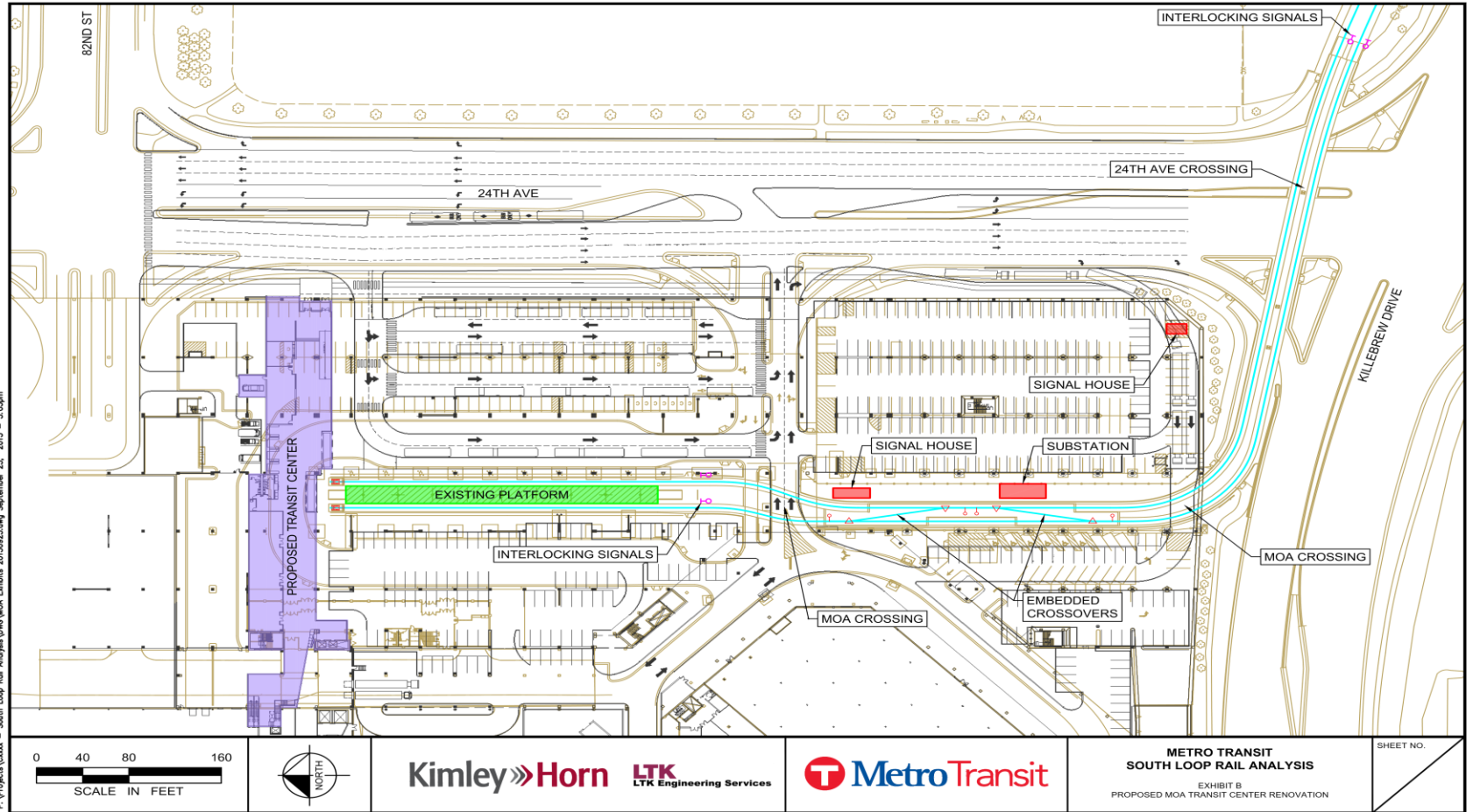


# Current Configuration



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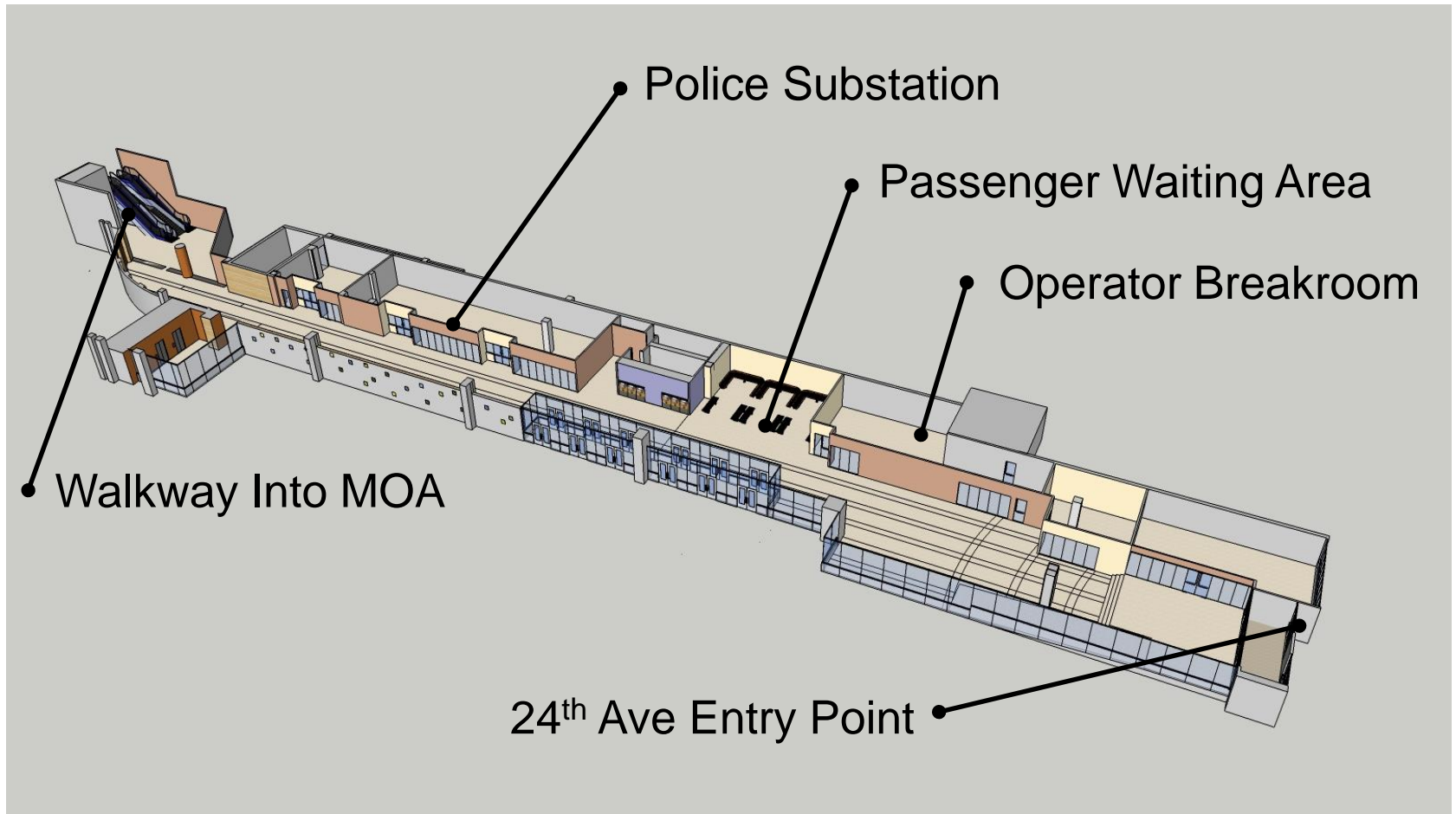
# Proposed Configuration
