Facility History

- Rail Built in 1992 as a Bus Time Transfer Facility
- Modified in 2004 for the opening of Light Rail
 - Remodeled Transit Station Waiting Area
 - Addition of LRT tracks
 - Reduced number of bus gates
 - Divided the area
- Added Red Line Platform in 2014




Project Objectives

- Eliminate Bus Waiting at Station Entry.
- Locates High Frequency/Capacity Services in Close Proximity.
- Eliminates Need for Red Line and Blue Line Passengers to Cross Busway
- Provides preferred siting for Metro Mobility Operation
- Provides Convenient Waiting Area and Direct Access to MOA






Current Configuration





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
Proposed Configuration





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
Waiting Area Design Concept
