
APS Pole Mounting Adaptor



When Signal Poles are used for Push Buttons





"Saddle Adaptor" on Pedestal Pole



Used on existing pedestal poles.



Button in middle of sidewalk





ADA compliance isn't enough



Locate push buttons (PB) 6' min. from obstructions whenever possible to allow an adequate MAR.



Move PB to the back of landing when a 6' MAR can't be achieved.

Total system consists of over 600 miles of sidewalk on MnDOT right of way.



Minnesota's Sidewalks



Of that 600 miles only 263.5 miles are considered fully compliant.








Typical Doorway Landings


