Purpose of the Coordinated Plan

- Plan for improving transportation services for older adults and people with disabilities
- Increase coordination among services
- Federally-required plan



Plan Application

- Guide federal funding investments in projects that improve mobility for older adults and people with disabilities
- MnDOT runs statewide application process for Section 5310 funding
- Funds can be used for projects such as
- purchasing vehicles
- providing non-profit shuttle services
- improved accessibility such as sidewalks or accessible pedestrian signals
- mobility management



Current Plan Adopted in 2013

- Three Strategy Categories
- 1. Coordinate and Consolidate Transportation Services and Resources
- 2. Mobility Strategies
- 3. Community, Training, and Organizational Support



2019 Plan Update

- Steering Committee will help inform and guide the plan update
- Inventory of available services in the region
- Stakeholder workshop to identify current needs and strategies (anticipated in June)
- Work will be done through Summer 2019
- Plan finalized in Fall 2019
