#### **Reconstruction Purpose**

  - Improve pedestrian and bike safety
  - Improve multi-modal options in downtown




- Updated TAAC in September 2018

  - Minneapolis Pedestrian Advisory Committee
  - Minneapolis Bicycle Advisory Committee



#### **Reconstruction Overview**



- Roadway and sidewalk reconstruction
- Removing left turn lanes at most locations, increasing space behind the curb including bikeway



## **Bus Stop Layout**



 Bus stop design will be consistent along corridor, layout consistent with A Line bus stations







## **Bus Stop Space**



- Bus stops at curb, bikeway between bus stop and sidewalk
- Designated crossings of the bikeway to the bus stop










### **Other Project Improvements**

- Straight and consistent pedestrian route along the corridor
- APS push buttons and pedestrian ramp improvements at all intersections
- Accessibility improvements at the end of Warehouse light rail station





#### **Reconstruction Timeframe**



- 12th St to 7th St: 2019-2020
- 7<sup>th</sup> St to Washington: 2021-2022
