### **Transportation Improvement Program** (TIP) Overview

- Four-year list of transportation projects funded in whole or part with federal funding
- Must include all projects funded with federal transportation funds and projects that affect air quality prioritized by year
- Required for all Metropolitan Planning Organizations (MPOs)
- Incorporated into MnDOT's Statewide Transportation Improvement Program (STIP)



## **Projects In the TIP**

- Transit projects programmed by Metro Transit/Council with FTA formula funds
- Roadway projects programmed by MnDOT with federal funds and state funds
- Regional Solicitation projects programmed by the Council
  - Bike/Ped
  - Roadway
  - Transit
- Small number of projects in Sherburne County / Wright County and Houlton, Wisconsin.

Council approval is for all project types in the TIP

### Schedule for 2023-2026 TIP

- TAB release draft for public review May 18, 2022
- Public review/comment period ends July 5, 2022
- TAB considers comments, recommends approval August 17, 2022
- Transportation Committee September 12, 2022
- Metropolitan Council approval September 21, 2022
- MnDOT inclusion into STIP September/October 2022
- Federal approvals November/December 2022

## **45-Day Public Review Period**

**Goal:** Gather feedback, information about impact, and other community knowledge related to regional transportation projects

Audience: Residents, commuters, business owners, community organizations, advocacy organizations

#### Approach:


- Email, web posting, and social media to promote public comment period and public meeting
- Coordinate communications and promotion of public comment period and public meeting with project sponsors, community organization, other connection points for stakeholder groups.
- Host "virtual" public meeting.

**Results:** 30 comments from 18 different people/agencies.
