BACKGROUND AND PURPOSE OF ACTION: Federal regulations require that a Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) be developed at least every four years. The Metropolitan Council revises its TIP every year in conjunction with the Minnesota Department of Transportation's State Transportation Improvement Program (STIP). The final 2015-2018 TIP is a separate action item. Public comments were collected over a 45-day public comment period.

RELATIONSHIP TO REGIONAL POLICY: Federal law requires that all transportation projects that will be partially funded with federal funds must be in an approved Transportation Improvement Program and meet the following four tests: fiscal constraint; consistency with the adopted regional transportation plan; air quality conformity and opportunity for public input. It is the TAB's responsibility to adopt and amend the TIP according to these four requirements.

STAFF ANALYSIS: A public comment period was conducted from June 23 through August 8, 2014, and comments were accepted by email, mail, or telephone. Three comments were received relating to projects included in the 2015-2018 TIP, and these are attached.

The Minnesota Department of Transportation (MnDOT) has worked closely with the staff of the Metropolitan Council and the Transportation Advisory Board (TAB) and the Technical Advisory Committee (TAC) in development of the draft 2015-2018 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP). As part of our normal process, several minor changes to both local and MnDOT projects have occurred since that time, including end-of-year changes affecting a number of individual projects.

The attached tables identify the individual proposed changes to the draft 2014-2017 TIP. These changes are, for the most part, end of fiscal year balancing changes, and projects shifting among years of the TIP along with any additions or deletions.

From a program perspective, there are some notable changes. A number of projects were added as a result of project selection since the draft 2014 TIP, including projects in the Transportation Alternatives Program (TAP) and the Highway Safety Improvement Program (HSIP). In addition, the items listed as MN999 (districtwide setaside) as well as SPs 2781-447 and 2758-75 were shifted out of FY 2018 in order to maintain fiscal balance statewide in 2018. However, development of those projects is continuing so that they will be ready to deliver in 2018 if funds become available. In addition to the above noted changes in these tables, some changes have been made to "Advance Construction" and "Advance Construction" paybacks due to projects moving between years of the TIP, and actual project letting costs have been updated.

With the proposed changes, the TIP remains fiscally balanced in the first two years, and generally balanced in the remaining years. These proposed changes do not affect the air quality conformity analysis of the TIP, as we have discussed with staff of the Minnesota Pollution Control Agency and the Metropolitan Council.

Thank you for the opportunity to comment on the 2015-2018 TIP for the Twin Cities area by providing these proposed changes.

On behalf of the City of Maple Grove, this is to provide comment relative to the proposed 2014 – 2017 TIP Amendment and the draft 2030 TPP Amendment intended to include the third general purpose lane along I-494 between I-394 and I-94. The City of Maple Grove has participated in the planning of this project since 2003 when the scope of the project included the reconstruction of the Fish Lake Interchange as well as the current proposed improvements. The project evolved over the years to only provide for the third general purpose lane, thence the notion of a dynamic shoulder lane and now back to what was proposed in 2011 as the third general purpose lane. It remains the position of the City of Maple Grove that the project should include the reconstruction of the Fish Lake Interchange to remove the existing hazardous condition of merging and weaving lanes over a short distance. However, recognizing a constrained budget this is to provide support for the TIP Amendment and the TPP Amendment to advance the third general purpose lane as soon as possible.

Thank you for the opportunity to comment on the two proposed amendments and please enter this into public record pursuant to the Metropolitan Council public review process.
