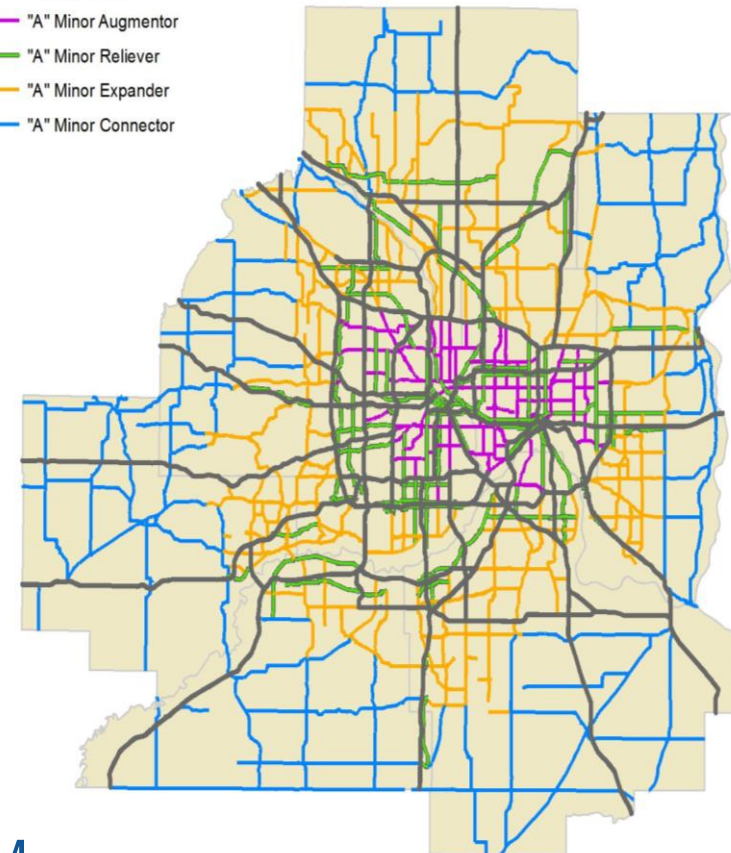
TAB Meeting



Major Changes Approved by TAB Before 2016 Funding Cycle

1. Fund \$10M-\$15M for Bridges
 - Funded 2 bridges, \$14M total
2. Change scoring to accommodate RR Grade Separation projects
 - Funded 1 RR Grade Separation (Foley Blvd in Anoka County)
3. Fund at least one project in each functional classification
 - Funded 1 project, but required skipping over 15 higher-scoring projects
4. Retain \$5.5M max award for Multiuse Trails
 - Funded 3 trail projects greater than \$5M

Survey Themes

- Interchanges dominated the Roadway Expansion category
- Reassess transit application categories and projects types
- The drawbacks of proportionate scoring (i.e., “outliers”)
 - Scoring Committee flexibility
- Freight measure has low point value
- Housing performance score is not project-related
- \$5.5M maximum award for trails reduces number of projects funded
- Better capture the negative impacts of projects with regard to equity scoring
