TAB Direction on 12/19

1. Reduced the funding scenarios from 5 to 2:
 - Base-Plus Scenario
 - \$4M for the St. Paul Unique Project
 - Favorable treatment for the removed Hennepin County Osseo Road project
 - Expansion-Heavy Scenario (Transit and Roadway)
 - No St. Paul Unique Project
2. On a split vote, the Base Plus was approved as the preferred scenario

TAC Recommendations on 1/2

1. Overprogram up to 10.5% with these extra projects:

Base Plus:

- Fully funds the MVTA Orange Line Connector (increase from \$1,500,000 to \$2,744,000)
- Fully funds Metro Transit Route 6 (increase from \$6,724,000 to \$7,000,000)
- Adds Apple Valley Safe Routes to School (\$198,240)
- Adds Bloomington Safe Routes to School (\$301,782)

Expansion-Heavy:

- Adds Burnsville Cliff Road at I-35W South Ramps Roadway Reconstruction/Modernization project (\$2,632,000)
- Adds Apple Valley Safe Routes to School (\$198,240)
- Adds Bloomington Safe Routes to School (\$301,782)

TAC Input on 1/2

- No recommendation between the two Base Plus and Expansion-Heavy scenarios
- Both scenarios provide geographic balance
- Difficult from a technical perspective to provide favorable treatment to the Hennepin County Osseo Road project
- Expansion-Heavy follows traditional approach of picking projects within a competitive scoring process--no large unique projects that reduce available funds for other projects

Differences in the 2 Scenarios

Base Plus Scenario

- Funds the Saint Paul HOURCAR unique project.
- Funds the Metro Transit Route 6 transit modernization project on Hennepin Avenue.

Expansion-Heavy Scenario

- Funds the Southwest Transit Prime Service Transit Expansion.
- Funds a currently missing I-35W on-ramp on the Anoka/Ramsey County border (Anoka County is the sponsor).
