1. 2019-14: Streamlined TIP Amendment: I-35W) (Transportation Comm. – March 11, 2019)

Requested Action: MnDOT requests an amendment to the 2019-2022 TIP to change the scope of its I-35W pavement rehabilitation project (SP # 2782-330)

Motion: That the Transportation Advisory Board adopt an amendment into the 2019-2022 TIP to change the scope of MnDOT's I-35W pavement rehabilitation project (SP # 2782-330)

Questions:

- 1. Why did cost not go down, because 1/3 less road distance is repaved?
- 2. Is there any estimated timeline on when the APS will be installed; and is there any idea of what it means to pedestrians who use the Washington ramp? Or, would the APS be installed at a later time, but still by the time everything reopens?

<u>Motion</u>: That the Transportation Advisory Board recommend that the Metropolitan Council release the draft amendment to the 2040 Transportation Policy Plan for public review and comment to extend the METRO Gold Line project and add lanes along I-94 from Dayton Parkway to MN 101
