MnDOT, Mike Barnes:

Barnes reported on CARES funding coming to Minnesota.

MPCA, Todd Biewen:

Biewen reported on the VW Settlement and what has been funded with the money.

MAC, Carl Crimmins:

Crimmins reported that the airport has won two awards for meeting the highest standards for cleaning, sanitation, and safety. MAC also won a Patriot Award for being Employer of the Year. Passenger travel is down 66% from 2019.

Metropolitan Council, Deb Barber:

Barber reported that the Regional Solicitation will be going to the Council on the 27th for concurrence. There is also transit funding coming through the COVID stimulus package. The Council has also worked to facilitate the vaccination process for the metro area transit workers.

Sanger asked about the delays in Southwest light rail construction. Barber said cost and timing impacts are being evaluated and she can return with more detail.
