What is a TIP?

- Four-year list of transportation projects funded in whole or part with federal funding
- Must include all projects funded with federal transportation funds and projects that affect air quality prioritized by year
- Required for all Metropolitan Planning Organizations (MPOs)
- Incorporated into MnDOT's Statewide Transportation Improvement Program (STIP)

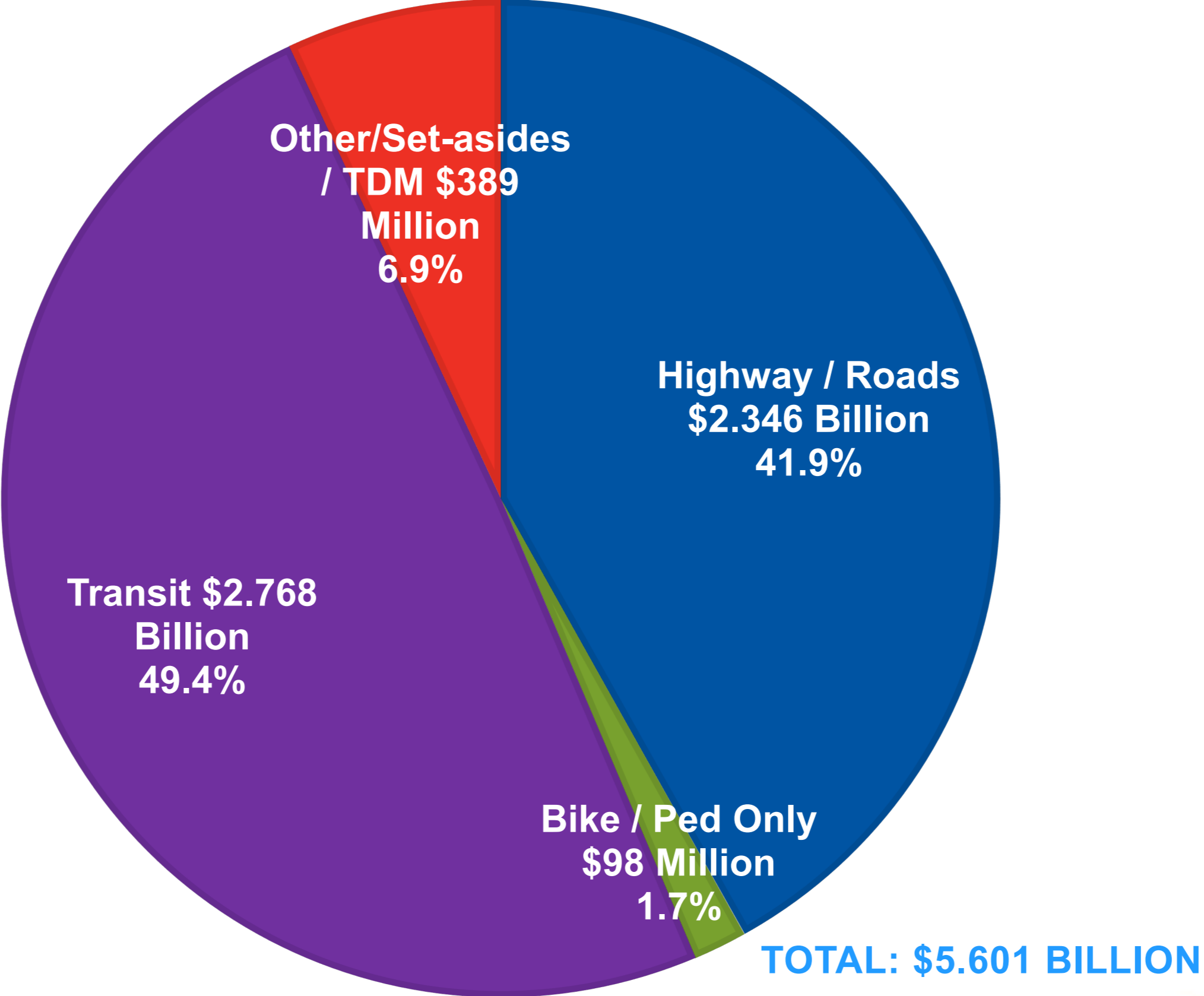
Schedule for 2023-2026 TIP

- TAB release draft for public review – May 18, 2022
- Public review/comment period ends – July 5, 2022
- TAB considers comments, recommends approval – August 17, 2022
- Transportation Committee – September 12, 2021
- Metropolitan Council approval – September 21, 2021
- MnDOT inclusion into STIP – September/October 2022
- Federal approvals – November/December 2022

Source of Funds; Four-Year Summary

- Federal Highway – \$1.5 Billion
- Federal Transit – \$1.6 Billion
- Property Tax and State Taxes – \$1.8 Billion
- Trunk Highway – \$530 Million
- **Total – \$5.6 Billion**
