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What's the problem?

- Over 70% of Minnesota's pedestrian infrastructure is not ADA-compliant
- Small contractors have little experience with ADA specs

Goal: Grow the pool of local small businesses* able to perform ADA construction and inspection work and help make pedestrian infrastructure accessible to all Minnesotans

MnDOT Small Business Opportunity Program



- Train small businesses in basics of ADA specifications
- Identify walkways and ped ramps that require basic ADA refurbishment
- Use quick and simple contracting methods (Negotiated Maintenance & Construction contracts)
- Right-size contracts to reflect capacity of small businesses and avoid attracting large contractors
- Provide continuous support and feedback to contractors

Develop the capacity of local small businesses in Anoka County to perform ADA construction and inspection work in accordance with MnDOT specifications on State or County Right-of-Way.



Fourteen Intersection projects in Anoka County completed!

14 construction contracts awarded

- 3 small businesses
- 2 TGB/DBE/Vet certified
- 2 CERT Certified
