# Draft 2017-2020 Transportation Improvement Program



#### What is a TIP?

- Four-year list of transportation projects funded in whole or part with federal funding
- "Regional Capital Improvement Program" for use of federal transportation funds
- Must include all projects funded with federal transportation funds and projects that affect air quality prioritized by year
- Required for all Metropolitan Planning Organizations (MPOs)



## Key Criteria for TIP and Amendment Approvals

- Consistent with expected funding level fiscally balanced
- Consistent with regional transportation plan (TPP)
- In conformity with Clean Air Act requirements
- Opportunity for public input




#### Schedule for 2017-2020 TIP

- TAB approves draft for public review June 15, 2016
- Public review/comment period ends Aug 3, 2016
- TAB considers comments, approval Aug 17, 2016
- Transportation Committee September 12, 2016
- Metropolitan Council concurrence September 28, 2016
- MnDOT inclusion into STIP September/October
- Federal approvals November 2015

## Source of Funds 4-Year Summary

- Federal Highway \$983 Million
- Federal Transit \$1.15 Billion
- Property Tax and State Taxes \$1.18 Billion
- Trunk Highway \$523 Million
- Wright/Sherburne/Wisconsin \$40 Million
- Total \$3.89 Billion



### FY 2017 Setaside

- \$10.8 Million to be programmed for Final TIP
- At TAC in July

- TAB June 15<sup>th</sup> meeting approval of draft for public comment
- Public comment period runs June 20 Aug 3
- Goes to TAB after comment period
